

## Message from Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. Today's Feast marks the conclusion of the Christmas Season and the beginning of Ordinary Time. It's a feast of transition from Jesus' hidden life to that of His public ministry. It also echoes the theme of the Epiphany in that the Baptism of the Lord is another manifestation announcing Jesus' divinity to all of His first followers and to the disciples of John the Baptist.

Above all, it needs to be pointed out that Jesus did not need the baptism of John. John was baptizing as a call to and sign of interior repentance. Jesus had no need to repent. But, nonetheless, He comes to John. John resists at first but Jesus insists. So the, why did He receive baptism?

First, by accepting the baptism of John, Jesus affirms all that John has said and done and affirms his sacred role of preparing the way for Jesus and for a new era of grace. Therefore, the Baptism of Jesus acts as a bridge between the Old Testament prophets (of which John was the last) and the New Testament era of grace and truth.


Second, it has been said that when Jesus entered the waters of baptism, He was not baptized by the waters, rather, His Baptism was one in which all the created waters of this world were, in a sense, "baptized" by Him. By entering into the waters, Jesus sanctified water and poured forth His grace making all water the future source of salvation.

Third, the Baptism of Jesus was an epiphany. It was a moment of manifestation. As He emerged from the waters, "Heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from Heaven, 'You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.'" This manifestation of the sonship and divinity of Jesus took place in a physical, audible and visible form so that all present would know, without question, that Jesus was the Son of the Father. Thus, His baptism is a way in which the Father introduced His Son and His Son's mission to the world.

At Jesus' baptism, God affirms his Son's mission for salvation. God announces his pleasure with Jesus and, in Matthew's Gospel, announces to all that, "This is my beloved Son" (Matthew 3:17). With this affirmation, Jesus is able to resist the temptations described next in Matthew's Gospel and to begin his public ministry. As family members, we can support one another in our Christian living by affirming the importance of each person in our eyes and in God's. Confident that through our Baptism we too were made children of God, we can resist temptation and share in Christ's mission.

## ***Family Reflection Corner***

### **Weekly Readings Reflections**

#### **Baptism of the Lord**

**Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:**

- Our commitment in Baptism is to be a servant of God, spreading the Good News of Jesus to others. Discuss one action that you could do as a family this week to spread the Good News of Jesus to others.
- Bring out pictures and remembrances of the Baptism of each family member. Then tell the story of those events.
- Place holy water in a special dish near the entrance of your home. Encourage family members to bless themselves with the Sign of the Cross each time they enter or leave the house.
- Discuss these questions: What are we called by our Baptism to become? Where do we get the power to do this? How does the Spirit act in our lives?

## **Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !**

### **Question: What is the mysterium fidei and memorial acclamation?**

**Answer:** In earlier explanations of the Mass, we recognized that the Liturgy of the Eucharist is always offered to God the Father. There is an interesting interruption, however, in this beautiful prayer of Christ to the Father. Once the priest proclaims *mysterium fidei* (the mystery of faith) after consecrating the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, we direct our words to Jesus himself truly present on the altar. There are three proclamations known as memorial acclamations allowed to be used in the sacred liturgy. Here at Notre Dame De La Mer, we sing/recite:

*When we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim your death O Lord until you come again*

When we sing the acclamation, we acknowledge, literally, the mystery of faith—Jesus' true presence in the form of bread and wine. It is also in the Eucharist that we celebrate the Paschal Mystery (the Passion, death, Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus). This is a reminder that we are called to partake in such a mystery. We partake in the Paschal Mystery every time we go to Mass and receive Holy Communion. In this Mystery, we are called to die and rise with Jesus.

This is why in the acclamation; we mention this bread and this wine to signify the true presence of Jesus after his Resurrection. We mention the death which involves the suffering he endured for us. We recognize with faith that he will come again just as he ascended into heaven.


