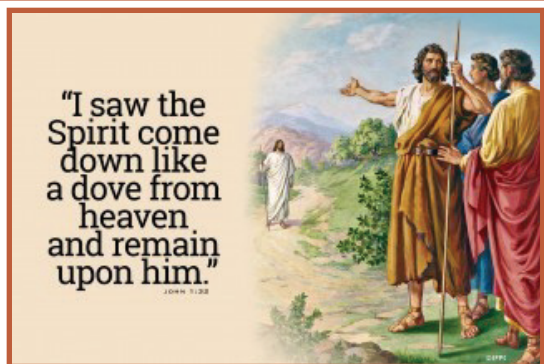

Message from Kevin Brady, Lead of Missionary Disciple Ministry

Brothers and Sisters,

I am sure you have been hearing a lot about our upcoming Parish Mission on January 25th and 26th. I just want to take a moment to emphasize the importance of this Mission to our parish and to our Church. We all know that the family has been under a cultural assault for the past few decades. There are many sociological explanations for the stark deterioration of strong marriages, along with strong nuclear families. Nevertheless, we all know the clarion cause for weakening the family structure stems from the abandonment of Jesus Christ in many homes today. Less and less people have a relationship with or even knowledge of Jesus Christ, and it unfortunately shows.

Sadly, survey after survey show many Gen Xers and Millennials have left the Church and religion all together. We live in a time when our children and grandchildren are not hearing or experiencing the love that Jesus Christ has for us. They follow an empty, godless, secular culture. Accordingly, we are now witnessing the deleterious consequences. We see a significant drop in Church attendance, along with an alarming increase of the Nones – those with no religion and no real knowledge of God. Unfortunately, we also see a commensurate increase in cases of debilitating depression, in drug addiction and in suicide among our younger people.

All the studies and surveys show us what we already know. Solid families, who attend Church, with Jesus at their center, experience these type tragedies at a much, much lower rate. Bringing Jesus to our families, friends, and acquaintances, not only brings them eternal salvation, it brings them better overall lives. Jesus gives us His “Great Commission” to evangelize because He loves us and wants us all to have better lives. Regrettably, we see the tragically adverse effects when we, as a parish or Church, don’t step up to the plate to answer His clear command.

As committed Catholics we must reach these lost generations and share with them the possibility of a real relationship with God Almighty. We want to reach out to those generations who are not totally committed to their faith, and to their children’s faith. We need to reach them for their individual salvation and for the survival of our Church in this post Christian world. We ask that you keep this Mission in your daily prayers and that you reach out to some in the 30 to 50-year-old generation. Invite them to join us. You will give them the opportunity to embrace a blessed and fulfilled life

In addition, while in prayer, ask the Holy Spirit to teach you something new and holy at this Mission. Ask Him to strengthen your relationship with Christ and His Blessed Mother. He will answer.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflections

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- To focus on Jesus' identity, spend an evening or a Saturday helping the members of your family put on a play or put together a puppet show about Jesus. Later, invite relatives or friends to watch the show.
- Choose your family's favorite stories about Jesus and read them to the children as bedtime stories.
- Who is Jesus for you? Talk with family members about what each person believes about Jesus and what it means to follow him.
- Gather together and ask each family member to think of one name or title for Jesus. Write the names and titles on a sheet of paper. Discuss what signs in your home indicate that Jesus is the center of your household.

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Question: What is the Liturgy of the Hours?

Answer: Have you ever noticed in old films a priest with a small black book? Most people assume this is the Bible, but it most likely is the Breviary. The Breviary is a prayer book that contains three psalms, a reading from Scripture, a response, and a prayer. The two major hours, Morning Prayer (*Lauds*) and Evening Prayer (*Vespers*), include a Gospel canticle and intercessions. The Liturgy of the Hours, as the Church describes them, is the extension of the Mass. It is another way to continue the Mystery of the Liturgy throughout the day.

Although described as "hours," each "hour" only takes about 15-20 minutes. The reason for using the word hour is to signify the different hours of the day in which the proper set of psalms and prayers are to be said. For example, you shouldn't be praying Vespers at 9 o'clock in the morning. You should try to match up the hours with the proper time of day.

Prior to Vatican II, this was known as "The Divine Office" or simply "The Office." This form of prayer was excluded only for religious and priests. Ordained clergy then and even now are **required** to pray these "hours" by The Code of Canon Law (Church Law). Vatican II, however, recognized that the laity, meaning those who are not ordained, should also be encouraged to pray this beautiful treasure of the Church. This is why Holy Mother Church invites and encourages the faithful to pray the Liturgy of the Hours.

If you wish to experience praying the Divine Office, join us at 8:15 a.m. at Kelly Hall Monday through Friday and pray Morning Prayer with us!
