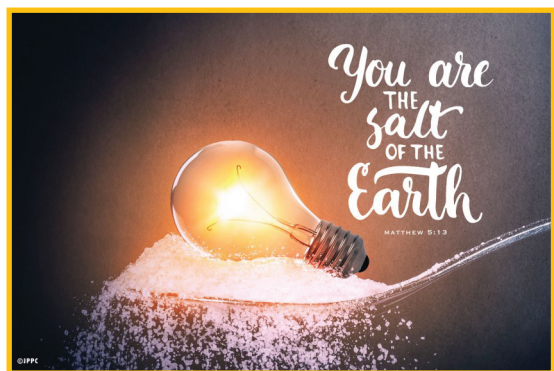

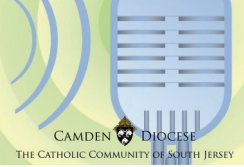

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflections

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- As a family, explore a dark closet or cabinet with a flashlight. Does the darkness overtake the light or does the light overtake the darkness? Light will always illuminate darkness. Discuss how this relates to the Christian walk. If one lets his/her light shine, how can darkness overtake him/her?
- Pop some popcorn for a family snack. Leave some of the popcorn unsalted and salt the remainder. Then salt a small portion too much. Can the salt be removed from the too salty popcorn? Without salt, how does the popcorn taste? Discuss how this relates to the Christian who maintains his/her salty walk despite what the world thinks. What is a salty Christian? How is one different from an unsalty one?
- Discuss a time when one or more family members experienced loss or failure (as the Israelites). Was it easy or difficult to shift from worrying to thinking of others' needs? Distractions from concentrating on disappointments many times lead to helping others, which ultimately might improve attitudes and feelings of well-being.

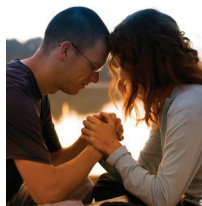
### Question: What is meant by a “Domestic Church”

#### Answer:

Sunday, February 9th is World Marriage Day, an opportunity to focus on building a culture of life and love that begins with supporting and promoting marriage and the family. National Marriage Week is celebrated from February 7-14. This year's theme is "Stories from the Domestic Church."

What is a “Domestic Church”? Every family is called to be a place of prayer, service, and love—a “little Church of the home.” Families naturally do this in their day-to-day lives: “The spirituality of family love is made up of thousands of small but real gestures” (Pope Francis, *Amoris Laetitia*, no. 315). They do this by strengthening the bonds of love among their members, and by asking the Lord's presence into their homes.
