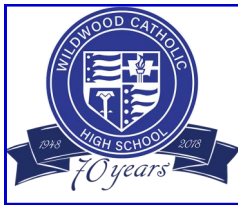

## Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

### Question: What are parables and why did Jesus use them?

**Answer:** *One of Jesus' favorite ways of teaching his disciples was through parables, using them to express profound spiritual truths.*

Throughout the Gospels Jesus uses parables to teach his disciples. What are they and why did Jesus use them so frequently? The *Catholic Encyclopedia* explains, “The word parable (Hebrew mashal; Syrian mathla, Greek parabole) signifies in general a comparison, or a parallel, **by which one thing is used to illustrate another**. It is a likeness taken from the sphere of real, or sensible, or earthly incidents, in order to convey an ideal, or spiritual, or heavenly meaning. As uttering one thing and signifying something else, it is in the nature of a riddle (Hebrew khidah, Gr. aigma or problema)... **it is intended to stir curiosity and calls for intelligence in the listener.**”

By their nature, parables have many layers of meaning. Often they do not have one specific interpretation and are open to spiritual pondering, exploring how the parable might reveal some truth in our own lives.

Furthermore, it was clear that Jesus used parables to help us penetrate mysteries that were too deep for us to fully understand. The Kingdom of God was one of the most popular subjects of Jesus' parables, which reveal to us the impenetrable nature of God's Kingdom and our inability to fully comprehend it on this earth.

Parables are also perfect examples of how the various senses of scripture are revealed. Each parable has a **literal sense** (conveyed by the words of Scripture and discovered by exegesis) as well as a **spiritual sense**. The spiritual sense of parables can further be separated into its **allegorical sense** (a more profound understanding of events by recognizing their significance in Christ); its **moral sense** (how they ought to lead us to act justly); and its **anagogical sense** (in terms of their eternal significance, leading us toward our true homeland).

### Parish Religious Education Program

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

**Children** in 1st-8th grade can either do our **School Year** program, which is held on scheduled Sundays, September-May at 9am followed by the 10:30 am mass at St. Ann's. Or our **Summer Intensive** program, which begins the last Monday in July through first week in August.

**Teenagers** in 9th-12th grade will be given a **RCIA** program geared to their age group.

**Adults** seeking the faith will be entered into the **RCIA** program. **RCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.

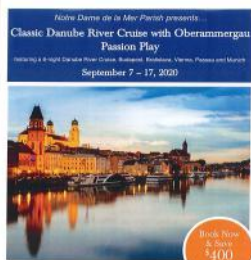
