Message from Deacon Nick Danze, Pastoral Associate

Dear Parishioners,

In times of suffering and pain do you have the courage of the 10 lepers to shout, **Jesus Master! have pity on me!** Or do you find yourself thinking: **why me lord?**

My friends, when ill health confronts us it is not uncommon for our thoughts to turn inward questioning God's love in allowing the medical condition. And ask, "why me?" But the truth is, that this side of heaven we have no assurance that god will always cure us, but we can be fully confident that He will always heal us even in the midst of our illness.

The lepers who met Jesus on the road to Jerusalem lived out their lives as ghosts...walking dead. They had been cursed by God; given a plague that did not kill, yet, never seemed to end. Where did they get the courage to raise their voices? What gave them the nerve to shout, **Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!**

I venture to say that most of us are probably pretty good at the "thanking God" part. And if we are being totally honest, we must admit that we don't always thank God perfectly. Sometimes our own egos get in the way, our own sense of importance and accomplishment.

One of our challenges today is to learn that being grateful to and for God and being grateful to and for our brothers and sisters are not two different things. Indeed, there is no way to be thankful for the good things that God provides without showing that same gratitude toward the people we come in contact with each and every day.

There was an old man suffering from Parkinson's disease that made writing difficult for him since he could not keep his hands still. One day he approached a young man at the post office counter to write a postcard for him. The man gladly consented and wrote what the old man dictated to him, and even signed the man's name to the postcard. When he finished he asked the old man, "is there anything else i can do for you?" The old fellow looked at the card, thought for a moment, and then answered, yes. At the end, could you just put: p.s. please excuse the bad handwriting!"

My friends, let's not be like the old man or the nine lepers and show **ingratitude**. Rather, let's imitate the one grateful leper and in our times of suffering and pain fall at the feet of Jesus, giving him thanks and having the courage to say: **Jesus, in your mercy have pity on me!**

HOSPITAL CHAPLAINS

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Question: What is the colored outer vestment the priest wears during Mass?

Answer: The colorful vestment the priest wears every time he celebrates Mass is called a chasuble. The word comes from the Latin word *casual* meaning "little house." One reason we used this Latin word as the base could be the fact that all the other liturgical vestments (alb, stole, cincture, etc.) are covered by the chasuble, thus literally making it a little house. This vestment at one time during the late Roman Empire use to be casual wear around town.

The main symbolism behind the chasuble is that it represents charity. Charity is the virtue that covers all virtues (Col. 3:14), just as the chasuble houses all the other vestments of the priest. When the priest puts the chasuble on in the sacristy, he is supposed to say a specific prayer. In this prayer, the priest compares the chasuble to a yoke (a yoke is crosspiece that is placed around the neck of animals to carry carts). The priests prays that while he carries out the work of Christ through the Mass, he may obtain a special grace from God.

Parish Religious Education Program

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children in 1st-8th grade can either do our **School Year** program, which is held on scheduled Sundays, September-May at 9am followed by the 10:30 am mass at St. Ann's. Or our **Summer Intensive** program, which begins the last Monday in July through first week in August.

Teenagers in 9th-12th grade will be given a **RCIA** program geared to their age group.

Adults seeking the faith will be entered into the **RCIA** program. **RCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.
