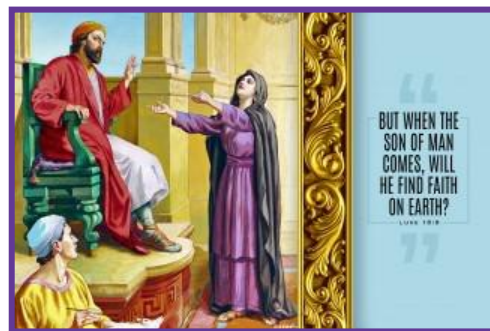

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflections

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- To help your family learn about persistence in prayer, teach or review with family members these formal prayers: the Sign of the Cross, the Lord's Prayer, the Hail Mary, and the Glory Be. Use these prayers as evening family prayers. You may also want to introduce the rosary and other traditional devotions of the Catholic Church.
- Use the Bible to help your family recognize that praying with Scripture is very important to prayer life. Have each family member take a turn reading a Scripture passage each evening. Discuss how each passage chosen is meaningful to your family.
- Take turns leading the family meal prayer, allowing each person a chance to make up a prayer or say the usual prayer alone. At the end of the prayer, ask family members to add any petitions they may have to offer.

## Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

### Question: Why do we Chant Prayers at Mass?

**Answer:** During Solemn Masses such as Christmas, Easter, Holy Days of Obligation, and funerals, you may have noticed that the priest will chant/sing the prayers and dialogues of the Mass. Chant is a form of singing that does not have a beat. Basically, it is speaking except your voice goes up a note or two, but it is not difficult. The reason for its simplicity is that it allows the priest and congregation to sing without the need of having amazing vocal skills.

Chant has existed in the Church since the first millennium. This is another gift the we have received from our ancestors in faith, the Jewish people. During their worship and ceremonies, they would chant prayers in Hebrew. The Church has picked up on this tradition, and it allows more focus on the texts of the prayers. If the priest chants, it slows down the words thus allowing the people to reflect on the meaning and intention of the prayer.

Chant also adds a style of solemnness or seriousness to the Mass. If we go to Mass every Sunday, everything can become routine. During these solemn seasons, however, chanting allows the priest and the people to take a step back and truly understand that God became man with the sole purpose to redeem humanity. That he died on a cross for you and me. That Jesus Christ conquered death by rising from the dead so that we may have eternal life. Hopefully the next time you hear the priest chant, you may reflect more deeply on the meaning of the prayer.

**Parish Religious Education Program**

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

**Children** in 1st-8th grade can either do our **School Year** program, which is held on scheduled Sundays, September-May at 9am followed by the 10:30 am mass at St. Ann's. Or our **Summer Intensive** program, which begins the last Monday in July through first week in August.

**Teenagers** in 9th-12th grade will be given a **RCIA** program geared to their age group.

**Adults** seeking the faith will be entered into the **RCIA** program. **RCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.
