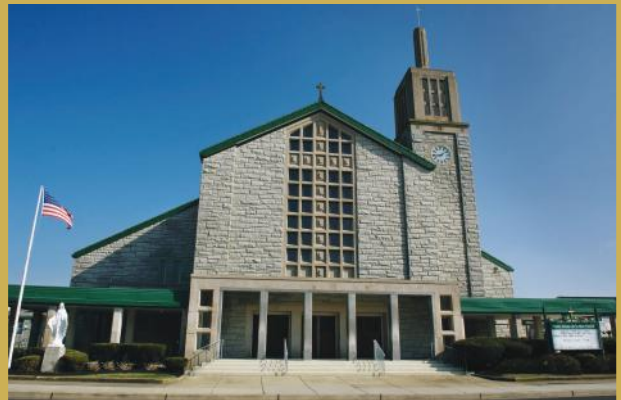

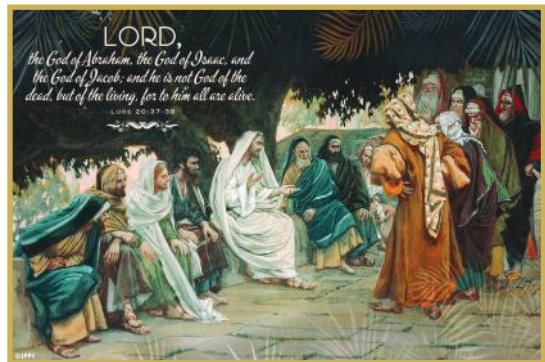

Message from Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

Dear Parishioner,

Stewardship encompasses much more than the generation of revenue. It is that call to each of us to support our parish in all ways possible. Stewardship draws upon the talents, expertise, and hard work of parishioners. Stewardship is not only a way to give back to the parish, it also is the best way to become involved, to meet people, and to feel a part of our Catholic community. I encourage you to make a commitment to be actively involved in the parish through all three of the following: attending and participating in Mass, providing financial support, and offering time and talent as service to the parish community.

Our gifts to the parish of TIME, TALENT, and TREASURE are given in gratitude because God has given so much to us. He is at work through us here at Notre Dame de la Mer, as evidenced by your generous contributions and participation in the sacraments, worship services, prayer groups, and outreach programs. It is what makes Notre Dame de la Mer and our schools a beacon of Christ's Light to the local and wider communities that we touch. As we review our many successes, we praise God for His spiritual effects on our lives.

One of the most important responsibilities of parish administration is the sharing of the financial activity of the parish with you. It is the goal of parish leadership to be transparent when it comes to the finances of this parish. In the center of this bulletin you will find a report that includes graphics and figures showing the expense and income breakdown for the 2018 – 2019 fiscal year, per the operating budget. Please note that this is not a balance sheet discussing all parish assets and liabilities. The discrepancy in income and expense for 2018 – 2019 can be explained by a lack of rental income received from the Early Education Program and also a decrease in ordinary income from what was budgeted. In addition to the expense and income breakdown you will also find a few other bits of information.

As always, there are maintenance issues that must be addressed, especially in our aging worship spaces. However, we are confident that most of the pressing issues have been addressed over the past few years. Some of the larger issues that still remain will be able to be addressed and remedied through funds that were pledged, but more importantly, collected during our CATHOLIC STRONG Capital Campaign. The projects are staggered and the timing depends on when the pledges are actually received. We have completed the parking lots, and are working on a few of the audio/visual enhancements for liturgy. Additionally, we are working on senior care at the local level through Vitality. This is an exciting venture that I hope is able to be rolled out during the upcoming year.

Our schools are undergoing a strategic change in operation. The consolidation efforts to create a singular PreK – 12 model under streamlined leadership is ongoing. We continue to need your support and prayers to help us make this venture a success for the parents and students in Cape May County that wish to have Catholic education as an option for them.

In addition to the quantitative data listed here, I gratefully acknowledge the generous efforts of hundreds of parish volunteers, who over the past year, have contributed thousands of hours to support our parish and its various ministries and activities. Our volunteers play a vital role in helping our parish live its mission and help to keep all of the facets of our extremely active parish running smoothly.

I hope that you have a chance to look over the report in the bulletin and if you have any questions please don't hesitate to come see me.

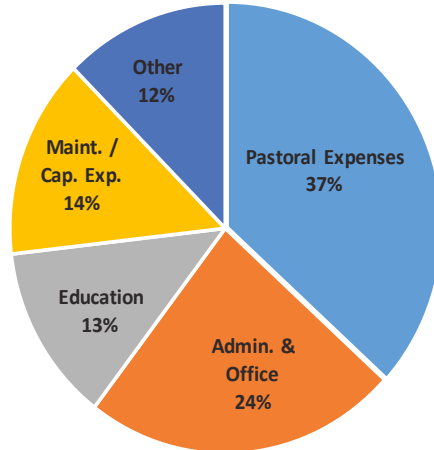

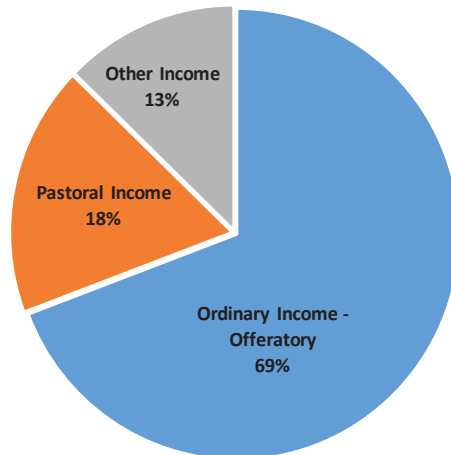

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflections

32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- To better understand life everlasting, take a nature walk as a family and observe the cycle of life and death. What do you see, smell, hear, touch or taste that teaches you about life or death? Does nature tell us anything about our own life and death? After your walk, come home, fix a snack, and share with each other what you observed and what you learned.
- Make a prayer list of members of your community, family, or friends who have died in the past year. Place the list in a special prayer space in your home. Every day this week, say a prayer for the people on the list.
- Talk about the changes that seeds go through to begin new life. Find a picture book at the library that illustrates these changes. Together with your child, plant seeds of a non-flowering plant. Discuss how seeds can show the journey from death to new life.

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Question: Who are the saints in the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I)?

Answer: You either love it and think it is the most beautiful prayer, or you think it is long and know your in for a longer Mass than expected. Once you hear the priest mention “with the glorious ever-virgin Mary, Mother of our God and Lord, Jesus Christ, and blessed Joseph, her spouse, your blessed apostles: Peter and Paul, Andrew, James, John...” You know the priest is using Eucharistic Prayer I, aka the longest Eucharistic Prayer. Yet, what do you know about Eucharistic Prayer I?

The nick name for Eucharistic Prayer I is the Roman Canon. Why? Because it originates in Rome. The saints listed in the Canon have special importance to the Roman culture. Obviously, we need to mention the major saints (i.e. Mary and the Apostles), but the specific saints (Linus, Clement, Sixtus, Agatha, Lucy, etc.) are those who lived after the Apostles. The reason for their names in such an important prayer shows that they lived a life worthy of Christ! Their loves served as examples to us, that we invoke their names to bring the Communion of Saints into our heavenly worship on earth. Mass as always been described as “bringing heaven down to earth.” It is only logical that we bring the Communion of Saints into the picture as well. Through their intercession, may we all live lives worthy of Christ.
