## Letter From Father Yvans

Dear Parishioners,

I want to start by wishing everyone a Happy and a Blessed New Year. May the Lord bless you and protect each and everyone of you during this New Year. This weekend we have the blessing to reflect upon the three important aspects of Jesus' life through Mary. This is the feast of Mary as the Mother of God, the first day of the New Year, and this is the Sunday where we are called to celebrate the resurrection of the Lord.

This celebration of Mary's feast on New Year's Day reminds us that the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God, which we call in the Greek language "Theotokos" is also our Heavenly Mother. Yet, Mary is our mother and the mother of the Church. As the mother of our Savior Jesus Christ, we honor her, respect her, love her and seek her intercession praying, "Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners." We neither ever, equate her with God nor replace God with her. Rather, we honor her primarily because God honored her by choosing her to become the mother of Jesus.

*"You are going to be the mother of a Son and you will call Him Jesus, and He will be called the Son of the Most High."* When the Blessed Virgin Mary visited Elizabeth, after the angel had appeared to her and told her that she would be the mother of Jesus, Elizabeth said, *"Why should this great thing happen to me, that my Lord's mother comes to visit me?"* [Lk. 1:43].

Based on these references in the New Testament and on the traditional belief of the early Church, the Council of Ephesus affirmed in AD 431 that Mary was truly the Mother of God. Twenty years later, in AD 451, the Council of Chalcedon affirmed the Motherhood of Mary as a dogma, an official doctrine of the Holy Catholic Church. Since Jesus is God and Mary is his mother, she is the Mother of God, Mother of the Messiah and the Mother of Christ our Divine Savior.

My brothers and sisters let us strive to be pure and holy like our Heavenly Mother. All mothers want their children to inherit or acquire their good qualities. Our Heavenly Mother is no exception. Hence, the best way of celebrating this feast and honoring our heavenly Mother would be to promise her that we will practice her virtues of faith, obedience, purity and humble service. In this way, we will be trying to become the saintly sons and daughters of our heavenly Mother, the holy Mother of God.

I want to ask you to keep 20 of us, in prayer, who will be leaving for Haiti on January 14<sup>th</sup> to serve the Lord through the people of Haiti. We thank you for supporting our mission with your good deeds. May the Lord continue to bless your family and friends, as we will continue to support one another.

### **Symbolon:**

**What is it?** A program from the Augustinian Institute that explains the Catholic Faith in a stunning video series. This series is filmed on location in Rome, the Holy Land, Calcutta and the studios of the Institute. The beauty of Catholicism is presented by nationally-known teachers who clearly present the beauty and brilliance of the faith.

**Who is it for?** Adult Catholics and non-Catholics and those in the RCIA process as well. Symbolon will enhance the knowledge of those who have been long-time Catholic. The programs will explain the faith to those that are not Catholic and it will assist along the walk of oneness in the faith for those who are in the process of becoming Catholic.

**How will the program work?** A segment of the program will be watched at the start of each session. A group discussion of the segment with starter questions will follow. The segments range from as short as 20 minutes to as long as 44 minutes. The discussion time after the watching of the segment will depend on the topic and the interest of the group attending.

**When and where will the program be offered?** The program will be offered beginning in January 2017. It will be offered at 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday starting January 18, 2017.
