## Message from Mary Vey, Administrative Assistant

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Epiphany. It is the time when Christians remember the Wise Men or Magi who visited Jesus. The Wise Men were: Gaspar, Melchior and Balthasar. They were from Persia, India & the Arabian Peninsula. The Epiphany is mainly celebrated by Catholics & Orthodox Christians. It marks the end of the traditional Christmas celebrations and decorations are removed. There are many different cultural traditions associated with the Epiphany.

In **Spain**, there is an important festival called -Fiesta de Los tres Reyes Magos (Festival of the three Magic Kings) where Spanish children receive their presents delivered by the Three Kings. There are similar traditions in **Mexico** where it is known as “El Dia de Los Reyes (the day of the Three Kings). It is traditional to eat a special cake called “Rosca de Reyes” (Three Kings Cake). A figure of the Baby Jesus is hidden inside the cake. Whoever has the Baby Jesus in their piece of cake is the “Godparent” of Jesus for the year.

In **Portugal**, people take part in Epiphany carol singing known as “Janeiros” (January songs) or “Cantor os Reis” (singing the kings).

In **Italy**, many children receive presents on the Epiphany. Many believe that a woman named “Befana” delivers them. Children hang stockings by the fireplace to be filled. Italian folklore states that the Magi stopped at her home on their way to find the Christ Child. The Magi invited “Befana” to join them on their journey. She refused citing she had cleaning and chores to complete. After they left, “Befana” regretted her decision. She gathered gifts and went searching for the Child. On the Epiphany “Befana” gives gifts to children in hopes she will eventually find the Christ Child.

In **Austria**, some people write a special sign in chalk over their front door. It is a reminder of the Wise Men that visited Jesus. The sign is meant to protect the house for the coming year.

In **New Orleans**, the Christmas Tree is either taken down or the ornaments are replaced with purple, Gold and Green. The tree is now the Mardi Gras Tree. People will eat the King Cake. The cake will have a small doll inside. Whoever gets the piece with the baby has to supply the next King Cake.

No matter your custom or tradition, the Epiphany is a celebration of the precious gift of the birth of Jesus!



## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflections

#### Solemnity of the Epiphany

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- Place the Magi into the crèche. Identify a gift you have to bring the Newborn King. Talk about the gift with family members and invite them to reflect on the gifts they wish to bring.
- Take a winter-night walk on a clear crisp evening. Find the North Star or any constellations you recognize. If you have any small children with you, remind them that the Wise Men followed the brightest star in the sky in order to find Baby Jesus. Help them find the brightest star in the night sky. Enjoy this facet of God's world.
- The three kings gave gifts to Jesus, and we just received Christmas gifts. Go through your books and toys. Make a special Epiphany box for the poor and donate the box to the St. Vincent de Paul Society or another place in your community that helps those in need.

## Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

### Question: What is the Epiphany of the Lord?

#### Answer:

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany. "The Lord and ruler is coming; kingship is his, and government and power." With these words the Church proclaims that today's feast brings to a perfect fulfillment all the purposes of Advent. Epiphany, therefore, marks the liturgical zenith of the Advent-Christmas season.

The Solemnity of the Epiphany is celebrated either on January 6 or, according to the decision of the episcopal conference, on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8. The young Messiah is revealed as the light of the nations. Yet, as the antiphon for the *Magnificat* at Second Vespers reminds us, three mysteries are encompassed in this solemnity: the adoration of the Christ Child by the Magi, the Baptism of Christ and the wedding feast at Cana. Extra candles and/or lamps may be placed around the sanctuary and in other parts of the church to honor Christ revealed as the Light of the Gentiles (*Ceremonial of Bishops*). It is customary to replace the images of the shepherds at the crib with the three Magi and their gifts.
