Message From Mrs. Carolyn Miller, Religious Education



Dear Friends,

Today is January 6. Feast of the Epiphany, Twelfth Day of Christmas, Wassail Day, Little Christmas, El Día de Los Reyes, Visit of the Magi. Whatever you call it, January 6 has an impact that is felt all around the world. For Christians, Epiphany is one of our oldest feasts. It has been celebrated since the second century, even before the Christmas holiday was established.

From the Greek word “to reveal,” Epiphany marks the discovery of Jesus in Bethlehem. (Matthew 2:1-12) Tradition tells us that the Magi were most likely three kings, Caspar, Balthazar, and Melchior, supposedly from Europe, Arabia, and Africa. If you read those twelve short verses in Matthew’s Gospel, it becomes clear that we know little about them. We don’t really know their names. We don’t know for sure where they came from. We don’t even know if they were kings. Some legends call them “astrologers” because they followed a star. But even the star is a mystery. Astronomers who chart the movement of the stars back in time, still can’t seem to explain this particular one.

According to Fr. Larry Rice, CSP, ‘regardless of who the Magi were and how the star showed them the way, the most significant part of this day is the identity of the one who is made known—Jesus. The appearance of mystical signs in the sky makes the point that all creation is now changed. Because God has chosen to become human, all creation can experience the redemption he has come to bring.’

Pope Francis recently pointed out that the Magi had the courage to set out on a journey in the hope of finding something new. These Wise Men who journeyed in search of Wonder, personify all those who long for God.

"The Magi experienced longing; they were...weary of the Herods of their day. But there, in Bethlehem, was a promise of newness. Their hearts were open...they could see what the heavens were showing them...guided by an inner restlessness...they were open to something new," the pope said.

Journey, star, revelation. That ought to be enough for one day. But I think we should also consider the gifts that the Magi presented to Jesus: Gold-acknowledgment of Jesus’ royal standing as “King of the Jews;” Frankincense—the divine nature of the baby’s existence, not an earthly king but the Son of God; Myrrh, often used to embalm corpses, emphasizing Jesus’ mortality — foreshadowing his death as a means to our redemption.

So incredible! Epiphany gives us much to ponder. The Magi and their longing for Truth and Wonder. This year, how far will we go to find the Christ? The Star, leading to newness and freedom. This year, what or whom will we follow? The gifts, tokens of all that God has done and will do for us. This year, what will we give to our God?

If Incarnation, Christmas and Epiphany are to make a difference in our lives, then we must live them and act on them. With courage to go the extra mile, anticipation for where we are headed, and generosity to serve the God who revealed Himself to us, 2019 will be a very blessed year indeed. May you always follow His Star!

Weekly Readings Reflections

Solemnity of the Epiphany

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- The word epiphany means to reveal or to be manifest. What have you learned about God from your family? Cut star shapes out of white paper, one for each family member. Have family members write their responses to the question on the paper stars. Older family members can write for younger children. Hang the stars in your home as a reminder of God's presence.
- Help your family experience a true epiphany. Spend time this week looking for God. Go out for a walk, or look for God in your home. See where God leads you.
- Epiphany is a traditional time for the blessing of homes. We know that we are part of the family of God and that God dwells in our home. Plan a blessing of your home. Use the following format: Read John 1:14 from the Bible. Then go in procession from room to room, blessing each room.
- Discuss these questions: What stops us from seeing God's presence in our world today? What helps us see God's actions and presence in the world around us?
