Go in search of FREEDOM while rooting your HEART in GOD.

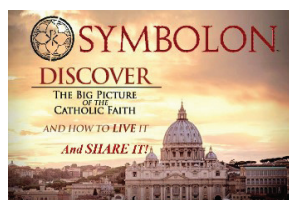
