## *From the desk of Donnamarie Black - Parish Catechetical Leader*

Dear Friends,

The story about the wedding at Cana is one of my favorite Gospel readings. It was the first miraculous sign that Jesus gave. It was the first time that Jesus revealed his glory. It is also when the disciples began to believe in him. When he called them, they knew something was different about him, but this first miracle helped them to really see.

What I love about this reading is how it shows Jesus as a loving, obedient son. At first Jesus wasn't sure if it was his Father's will for him to reveal his glory but his mother knew it was his time to shine and like an obedient son he listened to his mother. Mary couldn't make Jesus do anything. It had to be his decision. He had to know it was his father's will. Just like we can't make Him do anything if the time isn't right. God doesn't work on our cues. We must trust him with our plans and the timing of those plans. In doing so, we bring our plans in conjunction with his master plan and things work out much better. We must always wait patiently for the Lord. Since you can't make Jesus do your will, resign yourself to do whatever he says. Learn to listen to him. Obey him and you'll have much more peace.

All believers in Christ should seek to have the heart of Mary. Her heart sought to glorify the Lord, rejoice in him, and humbly serve him. She stored up his mighty deeds within her heart. She knew that his mercy was overflowing. He fills up the hungry and waits for the rich to realize their emptiness. When you resign yourself to doing his will, you may also get what you asked him for. He doesn't work on cue, but he does help us in our need. He is a very good and loving Father and Shepherd.

The servants blindly followed Jesus' instructions even though they had just seen those jars being filled with water. Were they shaking the whole time they walked to the master of ceremonies? Would they be fired if he took a sip of plain old water? Sometimes we need to do things that don't seem to make sense to our human minds. When we step forward in faith, despite our doubts, we may see a miracle!

Ordinary things can become extraordinary when they're blessed by God. God uses ordinary people. The disciples themselves were ordinary people before they were called. Believers today are similar. Before God called you, you weren't necessarily wise by human standards. You weren't necessarily influential.

The goal of a follower of Christ should be that Christ becomes more and more noticeable in their life. We want people to see him in us. When people see the courage and wisdom of ordinary people that are simply obeying God it stands out as being from God because their own meager efforts aren't that spectacular. But with God, ordinary things and people become extraordinary. God takes our empty places and fills them. He supplies our needs from his glorious riches, and we end up getting much more than we asked for originally.

Real faith is trusting in God for who He is, not what He can do. He is the God who loved you before you were born. If you're going to believe, you'll believe before you see a miracle, like Mary and the disciples. Seeing a miracle only solidifies a budding faith. It doesn't start the fire in your heart.

When you see miracles, healings, or answered prayers, take time to rest in your gratitude to God. Don't get so caught up in "what happened" that you forget Who made it happen.

## Readings of the Week

### Reading I: [Isaiah 62:1-5](#)

*God rejoices over you.*

- The first reading from Isaiah compares the renewed city of Jerusalem to a radiant bride of the Lord.
- The image of marriage was often used to describe God's covenant relationship with the people.
- In today's passage, this image was designed to hearten the discouraged Jewish people as they attempted to rebuild their city.

### Reading II: [1 Corinthians 12:4-11](#)

*One Spirit gives different gifts to each.*

- In the second reading Paul reminds the Corinthians that they should use their spiritual gifts with order and reverence.
- The gifts are from one Spirit and will build the Christian community into one body.
- The presence and the generous sharing of these gifts are signs of the messianic age, the glorious wedding feast of God's kingdom.

### Gospel: [John 2:1-11](#)

*Jesus' first miracle at a wedding in Cana.*

- Today's reading is the first miracle story in the Gospel of John.
- Throughout John's Gospel, Jesus' "hour" referred to the combined moments of his passion, death, resurrection and ascension.
- At the wedding in Cana, Jesus responds to his mother's request by performing a miracle to symbolize that hour.

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Plan a family celebration for the gifts that each family member has received from God. Each member should contribute to the celebration by offering something they created by using a talent God has given them. (For example, one child could play something on the piano; another could make a banner thanking God; another family member could bake cookies.) The celebration should include a short prayer service thanking God for the gifts.
- Go for a winter walk with your family as a reminder of the gifts of nature. As you walk together, point out all the wondrous gifts of creation. Make an arrangement of winter gifts to remind the family of God's abundance.
- Discuss the different ministries within your church and the people who use their gifts for the community. Have each family member write a note of appreciation to one of these members of the community.



**SAINT OF THE WEEK**

**Anthony the Abbot, Ascetic**

Anthony lived in an out-of-the-way place, a desert in Egypt, where he spent his time in prayer and meditation on the mysteries of God. When people came to him for wisdom, he reminded them that faith is not something to be proved but it is a gift which comes to us from God. His life of fasting and prayer was an example for many. "If you think me wise," he once said, "become what I am, for we ought to imitate the good... become what I am, for I am a Christian." Anthony reminds us to pay attention to what God wants in our lives. He followed the inner promptings of the Holy Spirit into the monastery. Like him, we must also listen carefully and follow God's will. St. Anthony is the patron of many things. Among them are domestic and farm animals, basket makers, and butchers.

His Memorial is celebrated on January 17.

**Anthony's message today:** Like his friend, Paul the Hermit, Anthony chose a life of contemplation, and put himself entirely in the hands of God. It is never easy to trust in God to take care of our needs unless we have strong faith in his goodness, something we can only develop through prayer.




