

CATHOLIC SCHOOLS' WEEK January 26 - February 1

Catholic Schools' Week is a national annual celebration and opportunity to recognize the importance, the value, and the contributions of Catholic education to the Church and the world.

There are more than 6,000 Catholic schools nationwide which serve elementary, middle, and high school students. They are located across all regions, giving many families the opportunity for accessible Catholic education.

The current theme for Catholic Schools' Week 2020 is *Catholic Schools: Learn. Serve. Lead. 

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflections

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- Discuss these questions: How does Jesus call you? How do you follow?
- With the family, discuss problems that are present in the community (vandalism, drug abuse, disrespect, racism, discrimination). Find ways that you as a Christian family can address these problems. Choose one and discuss what you can do to bring about a change with that problem. Spend time in prayer concerning your choice.
- Discuss with your child the divisions among people in his or her school. What are the reasons for the divisions? How can your family help?

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Question: What is the role of a Deacon?

Answer: Have you ever noticed another guy on the altar who dresses in vestments, but not priest vestments and does some of the things a priest normally would do, like read the Gospel? This guy is known as a deacon. A deacon is an ordained clergy member whose function is to assist the priest at Mass and in the parish. He may be noticed at Mass by wearing a stole over his left shoulder or by a dalmatic (the colored vestment resembles that of a priest except it has sleeves).

Deacons are the men who are at service of the Church. There are two types: transitional deacons, those who will be ordained priests and permanent deacons, those who will remain deacons. Deacons may witness marriages, perform baptisms, perform sick calls, and preside over funerals. They may also help in the parish with marriage prep, CCD programs, and the sort.

The title deacon comes from the Greek word “diakonos” meaning servant or minister. During the Mass, the deacon serves at the altar with the priest and helps him by preaching the Gospel. Deacons are permitted to give homilies as well. During the Liturgy of the Eucharist, he also helps distribute Holy Communion.
