

Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters



Let's ask ourselves: Who does God bless?
Who do we bless?

Today's Gospel answers these questions for us. The beatitudes promise God's blessings to those who are left out. You and I are called to make a difference by confronting injustice. The beatitudes turned the world upside down and blessed the 95% of the population who were poor, hungry and thirsty for justice. These were folks, like us, who were looking to God for help while suffering persecution. The Jews of Jesus' time, lived in an occupied territory, under Roman rule. Jesus challenged the ethic of "might makes right," because the Jews of his time were living under an occupying army who made them aware, daily, of their subservience.

In spite of this fact. Jesus grew up among the poor who worked every day in order to survive. The Jews farmed small pieces of land on which they grew wheat for flour, olives for oil, and they had grape vines and fruit trees. They also paid taxes to Rome, to Herod, and to the temple. Jesus promises them and us that God does not forget them nor us.

Today is the beginning of Catholic School's Week and we must look to another generation to carry out the beatitudes - BUT they must be able to look to us for the example of how to practice these mandates of Jesus. Let us ask ourselves if we are truly happy or blessed because we are poor in spirit. Do we prove our trust in the God who saves us; that he will console us in our sorrow? Are we meek, so that we might, one day inherit the land? Do we believe and prove that we hunger and thirst for holiness that we might have our fill? Do we show others mercy that we might receive mercy? Are we single-hearted in hopes that we will, one day, see God? Do we create peace – in our families, workplace or school – in order to be called children of God? Do we accept persecution for the sake of holiness, in order to, one day, dwell in the kingdom of heaven? And, last but not least, are we happy when we are insulted and persecuted for our faith because we truly believe that our reward in heaven will be great?

The beatitudes confirm Jesus' message for all times, and is meaningful for us today, since it seems that the motto for today is that "power and money rule". Various translations of the beatitudes use the word *happy* rather than *blessed* to introduce the statement. If we listen to various commercials, we find that, according to them, we might find happiness with a new car, or on a vacation, or with better windows or blinds etc. We know that this type of happiness is temporary and the happiness that Jesus promises us is everlasting. The kingdom Jesus envisions, values and lauds is promised to all of us who practice poverty in their lives, who suffer with the sorrowing, and show mercy. In other words, Jesus is telling us that when we act in the ways the beatitudes suggest, we are acting the way that God would want us to act. As we reflect upon these beatitudes, let us ask ourselves which one is th most difficult for me to imitate? Which is the easiest? How might we, no matter what our age happens to be, work together to break down the barriers to charity and justice.

Our first reading today also call us to seek justice and humility. Zephaniah, the prophet, preached to the people of his time, about the nearness of the day of the Lord. A day of wrath, devastation, darkness and gloom. Zephaniah realizes that the people need religious renewal and urges them to seek God, humbly – that people will no longer make of themselves gods, but will look for refuge in the Holy One. Zephaniah goes on to describe these people. They "shall do no wrong, nor speak lies, nor shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouths."

Let us pray for each other that we may we be blessed with the courage to follow Jesus, and those he has put in our lives to teach us and set an example for us to follow.



The Office of Child and Youth Protection is announcing CAP (Child Assault Prevention) sessions. CAP is the safe environment training program for adults who have regular contact with minors. Attendance is required in order to comply with the USCCB's *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. The policy of the Diocese of Camden is that adults will attend CAP once every five years.

<u>CAP 1</u> teaches attendees to **recognize child abuse and neglect** and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. CAP 1 is for new volunteers and employees.

<u>CAP 2</u> is called <u>CAP's Bullying Prevention Program</u> and is a workshop addressing bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyber-bullying is also presented.

<u>CAP 3</u> is called <u>Cyber-Empowerment</u> and is a workshop which promotes adults understanding of cyber activity of youth while teaching them realistic ways to help children keep their own rights and guard the rights of others in the cyber-sphere.

Each presentation is 90 minutes.

Adults who are new employees or volunteers should attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2 or CAP 3. After five years, adults have the option of attending CAP 1, 2 or 3 when they renew their CAP.


