Letter From Father Yvans Jazon

Dear Parishioners,

I want to start by thanking everyone for their prayers for the success of our mission trip to Haiti. It was a very touching time for both the Haitian children with whom we visited and our missionaries. When I was growing up, I never imagined one day I would be coming back to my hometown to spread love and light the lives of those who live in that town. This year, as many of you know, we brought 1750 solar lights, school supplies, and shoes to 7 schools and three communities in some villages where electricity is very rare or is not available at all. These children who live in some of these Villages do their homework and study with candles and kerosene lamps and many children share their writing instruments (pens and pencils) with siblings. During this trip, we also spent time at an orphanage which we've been supporting throughout the year. This is where a year ago we hosted a baptism for 27 orphans and most of us became Godparents. The children were so very excited to see us and we played with them and shared the gifts of school supplies, clothing, shoes, food, toys, and other incidentals with them. Plus, we fully funded their tuition, uniform and school books for the year, for 37 children!

What a beautiful idea to support these children and help them to know that someone in the world is thinking about them and praying for them. This solar light that each child received is one of the most precious gifts they could receive based on the testimony of so many of them. Yet, as they received the light, they shout "no more candle and no more kerosene lamps". Through your generosity, and the efforts of so many, we were able to make a difference in some areas in Haiti. Saint Pope John Paul II said once "Prayer of concern must lead of course, to the action of concern for others". Turning prayer into action is the teaching of Isaiah the prophet in today's first reading. Hand-to-Hand Mission to Haiti Inc., with the blessings of so many generous people, was able to see and experience God in so many precious little children we met during our mission trip. In the worldview, the poor and the needy should huddle in some dark corner where they do not have to be seen. But Jesus teaches us that we must shine the light of our goodness on those in need so that they cannot be ignored. Thank you for supporting our efforts to do this.

From this mission trip, so many hearts have been changed, and others have testified to the beauty of putting our faith in action. This is a coincidence, that I was asked to write the column for this weekend where the gospel of Matthew is reminding us that we are the salt of the earth and we are the light of the world. Physically and spiritually, we have experienced the effect of the Holy Spirit during this mission trip. We have been illuminated by the grace of the Holy Spirit to see the light and to put a smile on the face of each child we met on our way. We can say that we experienced the effect of sharing the light of Christ through our lives and our actions. Those who volunteered to take part of the mission trip shared their time, money, and love to the children of the villages we visited, also experienced the light of Christ in their lives. As they gave mercifully, they received God's mercy. Each one of us would personally thank everyone who was part of various groups of volunteers who supported our efforts back home. Without you, we would not have had these gifts to share with the children. We consider you as much of a part of the mission team as we are and if we could only give you a piece of the joy and love that we received, we would. You are most welcome at our meetings and we hope you continue to be a part of the team.

My brothers and sisters this world needs more people like you as missionaries to create bridges of love to reach out to others with kindness and compassion. In this way, we can bring more awareness about Christian communities as the light in the world, and we model this through prayer and good works, which then reap the fruits of God's grace. Once again, thank you to all of you who have been so generous to help with fundraising, packing the boxes, collecting and sorting school supplies, donating items, and so many ways to support us. It is our mission to bring the children in Haiti your gifts as we deliver them Hand to Hand. On behalf of the Haitian school directors, teachers, Sisters, parish Priests, and Cardinal Langlois, we extend their sincerest appreciation ,as they are so grateful for your love and support. May God continue to fill you with his light for you to shine in your community and may this light continue to shine through the darkness of the world.




