

From the desk of Sister Anne Lafferty - Spanish Apostolate

My dear friends in Christ,

Peace to you and your family!


As I was thinking and praying about what to share with you this week, it came to me the Church Year or Liturgical Year. What is it? Where does it come from? How is it organized?

The liturgical year, is an annual cycle of seasons and days observed in the church in commemoration of the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ and of his virtues as exhibited in the lives of the saints. Jesus is the center of the Liturgical year, the center of our lives in faith.

The mystery of Christ, unfolded through the cycle of the year, calls us to live his mystery in our own lives. This call is best illustrated in the lives of Mary and the saints, celebrated by the Church throughout the year. There is no tension between the mystery of Christ and the celebration of the saints, but rather a marvelous harmony. The Blessed Virgin Mary is joined by an inseparable bond to the saving work of her Son, and the feasts of all the saints proclaim the wonderful works of Christ in his servants and offer the faithful fitting examples for their imitation.

Each liturgical year begins on the First Sunday of Advent during the preceding calendar year (i.e., the First Sunday of Advent in 2021 began the 2022 liturgical year).

As you can see in the diagram below that the seasons are marked with the same colors as the priest's vestments, purple, white, green and red. There are three Cycles A,B,C we are in cycle C ,so we will be hearing Luke's Gospel every Sunday. Cycle A is St. Matthew, Cycle B is St. Mark. The Gospel of St. John is read at different times and on special feast days.



Mis queridos amigos en Cristo,

¡Paz para ti y tu familia!

Mientras pensaba y oraba sobre qué compartir con ustedes esta semana, se me ocurrió el Año de la Iglesia o Año Litúrgico. ¿Qué es? ¿De dónde viene? ¿Cómo está organizado?

El año litúrgico es un ciclo anual de estaciones y días que se observan en la iglesia en conmemoración de la vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo y de sus virtudes tal como se manifiestan en la vida de los santos. Jesús es el centro del año litúrgico, el centro de nuestra vida en la fe.

El misterio de Cristo, desplegado a través del ciclo del año, nos llama a vivir su misterio en nuestra propia vida. Este llamado se ilustra mejor en las vidas de María y los santos, celebradas por la Iglesia durante todo el año. No hay tensión entre el misterio de Cristo y la celebración de los santos, sino una armonía maravillosa. La santísima Virgen María está unida por un vínculo inseparable a la obra salvífica de su Hijo, y las fiestas de todos los santos proclaman las obras maravillosas de Cristo en sus siervos y ofrecen a los fieles ejemplos dignos de su imitación. Cada año litúrgico comienza el primer domingo de Adviento durante el año calendario anterior (es decir, el primer domingo de Adviento en 2021 comenzó el año litúrgico 2022).

Como puedes ver en el diagrama arriba , las estaciones están marcadas con los mismos colores que las vestiduras de los sacerdotes, morado, blanco, verde y rojo. Hay tres ciclos A, B, C, estamos en el ciclo C, por lo que estaremos escuchando el Evangelio de Lucas todos los domingos. El Ciclo A es San Mateo, el Ciclo B es San Marcos. El Evangelio de San Juan se lee en diferentes momentos y en días festivos especiales.

Readings of the Week

Reading I: Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8

Here I am! Send me.

- In the first reading, Isaiah gives an account of his prophetic call.
- Isaiah has a vision in which one of the seraphim touches his lips with a hot coal from the incense burner.
- This is a sign that his lips are cleansed to preach God's word.

Reading II: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

The grace of God is with us always.

- The reading from 1 Corinthians precedes the Gospel of Mark and is the oldest statement of resurrection faith recorded.
- Paul presents the Gospel's general outline in the formal pattern of rabbinical tradition.
- For Paul, the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is the culmination of things written long ago.

Gospel: Luke 5:1-11

The apostles were called and so are we.

- Today's Gospel story presents Luke's account of the call of the first disciples.
- In contrast to the story told by Matthew and Mark, here the disciples had a more resounding reason to respond to the call from Jesus.
- Simon Peter's response to the call reminds us of the response of Isaiah: "Leave me Lord. I am a sinful man."

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- The readings for this Sunday remind us that we are called by God to go forth and share the Good News. Decide as a family upon one action that would show your willingness to follow the way of Jesus. For example, visit a neighbor who is sick, offer to take a home-bound person shopping, invite someone who lives alone to dinner.
- Light a candle and dim the light in the room. Allow quiet time for God to speak to each family member. Encourage family members to listen to God's call. Each person could share what happened in the silence.
- Discuss the following questions with your family: In what ways can you use your gifts and talents to catch people for Jesus? What prevents you from following Jesus?

Wedding Host Ministry

Wedding hosts and hostesses set up the environment for the wedding celebration in church (placement of the bride and groom chairs, etc.) and greet the wedding party as they arrive for the rehearsal. They assist the Presider in the rehearsal, in some cases lead the rehearsal and answer questions of the bridal party. On the wedding day they greet the bridal party, turn on the lights, prepare the liturgical items, and generally serve as hospitality ministers for the bridal party before and during the wedding celebration. This ministry is an important part of the welcoming mission of Notre Dame de la Mer. Stipends are provided for the wedding host couple.

Time: About 1 1/2 hours for a rehearsal and about 2 hours for the wedding celebration. Wedding hospitality ministers usually serve at about four - five weddings per year.
