Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Parishioners,

The gospel of today closes with Jesus exhorting us to be perfect as God is perfect. In these words Jesus echoes the words that are used in Leviticus 19. (Open your Bible and read Leviticus 19) which is a collection of rules, for example: not giving idol worship, laws dealing with agriculture and animal husbandry, labor relations, fortunetelling, and many more. These rules like many others end, as does today's first reading. "I am the Holy One." The one rule that we should practice tells us that in order to be holy we must love our neighbors as ourselves.

In our day, the word holy has taken on the meaning pious. Holy people are saints and most of us are sinners. To be holy means to be different from and separate from the ordinary. God is holy and so are a few others. Karl Rahner wrote an article about the name God and suggests that we replace the name God with "Holy Mystery." The word mystery as Rahner uses it does not mean something we solve, but something larger than ourselves in which we are held throughout our lives. The word holy reminds us of awe and wonder.

So, be holy as God is holy means that we should be alive and let this mystery cause us to be united with others who have embraced this same "Holy Mystery." Do you know any holy people? If you have answered "yes" then why do you say this person is holy?

In today's gospel, Jesus teaches us how to be holy by turning the other cheek. Going the extra mile, and giving to those who ask. How often have we wondered and even asked: "what can I do to help?" Once again, what does Jesus expect from us? Maybe he is asking us to deal with anger in ourselves and within our families. Perhaps, he is asking us to be faithful to our spouse, and to keep our word and not make empty promises.

Jesus is also asking us to be like him and risk changing or accepting the violence and hatred others express toward us. Some examples of this non-violent resistance in our time are Gandhi and Martin Luther King, Jr. Non-violent resistance takes courage and action. It means standing face to face, and giving our face in order to be hit, rather than a fist to do the hitting. Jesus offers us an alternative to violence by teaching us to make neighbors of all – to those who need coats; to the violent from whom we must help keep others safe. Let's ask ourselves: when have we done more than expected, for someone who might need help; or when have we accepted someone we might have considered an enemy; or when have we just helped a neighbor without expecting anything in return?

We have all heard or perhaps have used the words "an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth." By our standards, today, that

statement sounds barbaric. Oftentimes, we hear of some cases in which the law punishes persons by using literal methods of that ancient code. We do not expect to hear of a punishment that does not fit the crime. In Sunday's gospel, Jesus is asking to take God as our measurement, for in how we should treat others. Jesus then goes beyond the golden rule by stating – "In everything do unto others as you would have them do unto you: for this is the law and the prophets." The golden rule then, makes we, ourselves the standard of how to treat others.

Jesus asks us to be perfect as God is perfect. We hear the word perfect much of the time if we listen to commercials for example – the perfect body, the perfect home, the perfect job, and all the other perfects including the perfect retirement plan. The word perfect implies that nothing more can be done. There is one scripture scholar who suggests that a better translation of the word perfect would be fully alive.

When one is fully alive, one is whole. Then one is able to use all their human potentials to know and love others, and to live the values and strengthen the bonds that hold us together as families, neighborhoods, and a nation. What does being fully alive imply for each of us? I believe that it implies engaging new people, events and needs with our whole selves. I also believe that the whole person not only notices the person who needs a coat; but a shirt as well. The whole person can think and decide what to lend the borrower. St. Irenaeus told his 4th century followers that the "glory of God is the human being fully alive.

What is a choice that has opened for you a way to live Jesus' new law? Are you able to identify, who in your neighborhood works to settle conflicts? Have you thought about how you might accomplish any of these issues?

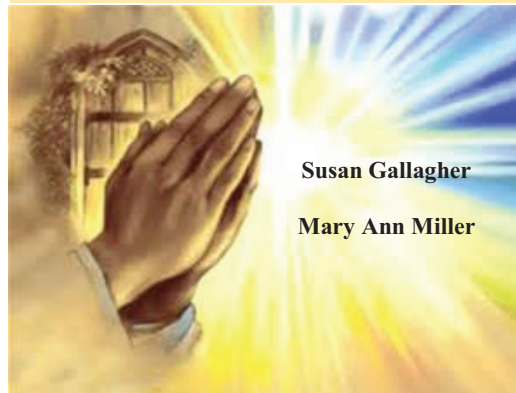

Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of **Fast and Abstinence from meat.**

There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter season.

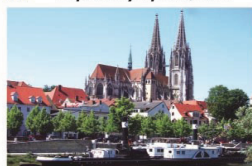

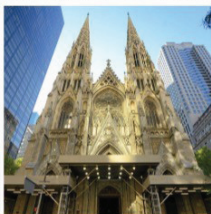

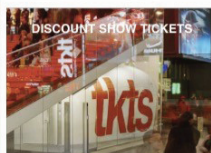
