Message from Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

Dear Parishioner,

Get ready! This coming week is Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of the penitential season of Lent. By ancient custom, believers will have ashes placed on their foreheads as they begin this forty-day preparation for Easter. As an aide to this preparation, the liturgy contains the proclamation of the Lord Jesus' teachings on prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Taken from the Sermon on the Mount, which is the greatest summary of the Lord's way of love, these instructions give a clear and challenging summons to the spiritual life of believers and to all people of good will.

In conversation regarding Lent, Pope Francis has said that "God in his providence offers us each year the season of Lent as a sacramental sign of our conversion. Lent summons us, and enables us, to come back to the Lord wholeheartedly and in every aspect of our life".

The purpose of Lent is not to make us feel disheartened or uncomfortable in the way we live out our faith, but it is a call to self-examination and for taking a fresh look at our attitude and behavior towards others. Often unknown to ourselves we can little by little become self-centered and lapse into indifference to others. During the Lenten Season the Church offers us the soothing remedy of *prayer*, *almsgiving*, and *fasting*. These are the three pillars of Lent.

As Catholics we certainly understand the power of **prayer** and its essential place in our Lenten exercises. The Holy Father says, "By devoting more time to *prayer*, we enable our hearts to root out our secret lies and forms of self-deception, and then to find the consolation God offers. He is our Father and he wants us to live life well."

What do we truly understand about **fasting** and its place in our lives? Pope Francis explains that "*Fasting* weakens our tendency to violence; it disarms us and becomes an important opportunity for growth. On the one hand, it allows us to experience what the destitute and the starving have to endure. On the other hand, it expresses our own spiritual hunger and thirst for life in God. Fasting wakes us up. It makes us more attentive to God and our neighbor. It revives our desire to obey God, who alone is capable of satisfying our hunger."

Of the three pillars of Lent, **almsgiving** is the one most neglected. In Tobit 12:8-9 we are told "that prayer and fasting are good, but better than either is almsgiving accompanied by righteousness. It is better to give alms than to store up gold; for almsgiving saves one from death and expiates every sin. Those who regularly give alms shall enjoy a full life". Pope Francis tells us *Almsgiving* "sets us free from greed and helps us to regard our neighbor as a brother or sister. When we give alms, we share in God's providential care for each of his children. If through me God helps someone today, will he not tomorrow provide for my own needs?"

Let us keep our gaze firmly fixed on Christ this Lent, both as a Church and as individual baptized Catholics, for in his own marvelous words he "is the way, and the truth, and the life" (John 14). Knowing Him is the ultimate meaning and fulfillment of life on Earth.



Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflections

7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- Have each family member share a time that his/her weapon of choice against evil was “good.” How was “good” used to conquer evil? How is Jesus’ life an example of good conquering evil?
- How is loving one another similar to God’s character? Discuss the community found in the Triune God. Father God, Jesus the Son and the Holy Spirit love and live as community. How is that community an example for all relationships? Why might that work so well? Have family members relate how difficult it is to love everyone and why it is still important to do so. How does forgiveness fit into the equation?

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Question: What are the Lenten Obligations that should be followed?

Answer:

- Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent* and Good Friday.
- Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
