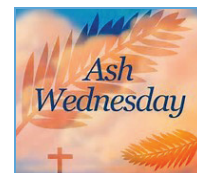

Dear Parishioner,

It's hard to believe that Lent begins this Wednesday! It seems as if we just took the Christmas decorations down. Please consult the schedule here in the bulletin or parish website for the times and places for the distribution of ashes on Wednesday. Also please take note of the Lenten regulations also found in this week's bulletin and parish website.

Lent is a time for the whole Church to enter into the great 40 day retreat that marks the time that our Lord spent in the desert before he began his public ministry. These days give us all an opportunity to reflect on our lives and ask God to help us to walk closer to Him as we attempt to divest ourselves of the worries and pursuits of this world. Lent is a time for extra prayer, fasting and alms giving. We are called to devote ourselves to the spiritual and corporal works of mercy that help us to center less on our vain pursuits in order to reach out to others in their various needs.

We are called and encouraged to make a good confession during Lent. Confessions are available every Saturday in both our churches starting at 3:30pm. We are also offering a Communal Penance Service on Wednesday, April 15 at 6:00pm at Assumption Church. This is a good time to ease our conscience as we unburden those things that we have done or failed to do through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Some of the other offerings we are providing for your spiritual growth this year are daily Mass at 7:00am St. Ann Chapel and 8:30am in Msgr. Kelly Hall. Every Friday of Lent we are offering The 7 Last Words of Jesus on the Cross at 5:30pm at Assumption Church followed by solemn Stations of the Cross at 6:00pm, also at Assumption Church. Every Wednesday evening at 6:00pm we will be participating in our local Ecumenical Lenten Soup and Supper gathering at one of the Christian churches on the Island. This is a wonderful opportunity to meet, pray with, have a simple supper and hear a spiritual reflection with our fellow Christians in our area. The schedule of these Wednesday gatherings will be in next week's bulletin and on our parish website. Our local Knights of Columbus Council #2572 is offering a Spaghetti Dinner to help benefit our ecumenical outreach to the local poor, Lazarus House and Hand to Hand Mission to Haiti on Sunday, March 5, 2017. Our Wildwood Catholic High School Drama Club is offering a contemporary presentation of Jesus in their show Godspell – two shows, Saturday, March 11th at 7:00pm and Sunday, March 12th at 2:00pm, in the high school auditorium.

I hope you will be able to join in these various offerings to enhance and deepen your Lenten journey. I pray we are all recharged and renewed through the blessed discipline of Lent.

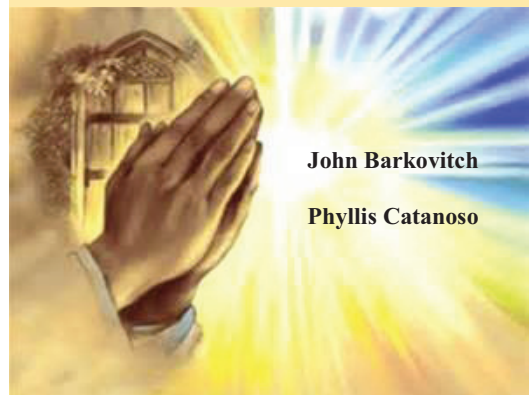

Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of
self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of **Fast and Abstinence from meat.**

There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all
between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain
totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Commun-
ion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiv-
ing Holy Communion at least once a year. This pre-
cept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season.
Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal)
sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the
Lenten/Easter season.

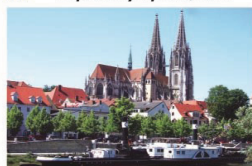

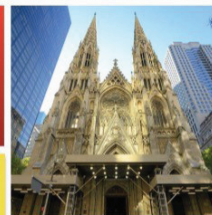

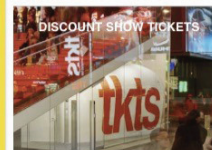
