# Letter From Jonathan Delgado

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the first Sunday in Lent. Lent gives us the opportunity to reflect and deepen our spiritual lives. We all seem to get caught up in what we should give up for Lent, whether it be chocolate, potato chips, alcohol or anything that might deprive us of our personal daily indulgences. This seems to be what most think Lent is about, however Lent is so much more, it is about reconnecting with the dynamic of not deserving something, and yet, receiving the best gift of all time – the promise of the Resurrection.

While the giving up is a good spiritual discipline for us all, there is also a way to connect to Christ's gift of life by doing something for Lent, this could include acts such as trying to make daily Mass, attending Stations of the Cross, visiting the homebound, volunteering at the Lazarus House or any act of kindness that allows us to bring Christ's love to one another.

This Sunday we are celebrating The Rite of Election with the RCIA candidates at the 8:30 am Mass. RCIA is The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, it is a formal program of Catechetical instruction, prayer and spirituality where the catechumens are formally admitted into the Church and receive the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. This rite usually coincides with the First Sunday of Lent. At this rite, upon the testimony of sponsors and catechists and the catechumens' affirmation of their intention to join the Church, the Church makes its "election" of these catechumens to receive the Sacraments of Initiation. In the presence of the bishop, they inscribe their names in the Book of the Elect at the Cathedral as a pledge of fidelity. They will then enter into the period of Purification and Enlightenment, the final intense preparation for the reception of Sacraments of Initiation. On the next five Sundays of Lent, three scrutinies (rites for self-searching and repentance) and the presentations of the Creed and Lord's Prayer take place. This period concludes with the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation at the most holy and solemn night out of the year, The Easter Vigil. Please pray for these candidates and if you see an RCIA candidate over the next few weekends at Mass please take the time to congratulate them for wanting to become full members of our Roman Catholic Faith, this will begin the part of the RCIA process which is led by us the Parish family of Notre Dame de la Mer, the process of welcoming!!!



#### Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

# Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

#### Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

#### **Easter Duty Obligation:**

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter season.


# REPORT SEXUAL ABUSE


