Dear Friends,

My sisters and brothers in Christ, John's Gospel today recounts how Jesus heals the man who was born blind. There are so many lessons contained in this amazing story; too many to review them all in this short reflection. So, let's focus on one of them, and that is that **OBEDIENCE AND FAITH COMES TOGETHER**.

Too many people today assume that all they need to obtain salvation is to accept Christ and believe in Him. That is certainly true, but falls well short of understanding what God expects of us.


If we are to have faith in God and His Son, we must couple it with **obedience** to God's commands and our surrender to His will. Christ didn't simply heal the blind man, which He could have done on the spot. It would have been so simple but, instead, Jesus takes the opportunity as a *teaching moment* for all around Him and for this blind man. In order for the man to get healed, he needs to GO and WASH in the Pool of Siloam. The man initially believed Jesus Christ, but he didn't stop there. *He also obeyed Christ's command.* Sure, it was difficult for the blind man to find his way to Siloam, but that is part of the healing process. Jesus is not just seeking to heal the man physically, **but also spiritually**. Believing in God is only the first step. It must be accompanied by **active faith**. As we read in the Letter of James:

Be **doers** of the word and not hearers only, deluding yourselves. See how a person is justified by works and not by faith alone.

The blind man would have not been healed if he didn't follow Jesus' instruction. Christ did His part and it is now the man's turn to do his.

How many of us would like to receive God's blessings, *but think God's commandments are optional?* Let us pray for the grace to be **DOERS** of The Word every day of our lives.

Reading I: 2 Chronicles 36:14-17, 19-29

Early and often did God send messengers to them.

- The Second Book of Chronicles was written after the Babylonian exile as a reinterpretation of history for the new situation in which the people found themselves.
- A major focus of hope for the returned community was the rebuilt temple, a sign of the return of God's presence.
- The people saw the destruction of the former temple as a punishment for their sins and a fulfillment of the prophets' warnings.

Reading II: Ephesians 2:4-10

God is rich in mercy.

- The Letter to the Ephesians emphasizes that God's salvation is a gift and not something earned by human effort.
- In the Hebrew Scriptures the major covenant virtues of love and fidelity are manifested in God and demanded of humans.
- In Ephesians we are told again that it is because of God's great love and abundant mercy that we are brought to life in Christ.

Gospel: John 3:14-21

The light came into the world.

- In today's Gospel, Jesus explains the truth seen in faith to Nicodemus.
- Those who choose eternal life receive it because of faith in Christ.
- Humans choose salvation or reject it just as they choose or reject life.

- Thank Jesus for the gift of faith. Pray the Stations of the Cross together with your family, or join your parish community in the Stations of the Cross.
- Make a poster with the words of John 3:16. Use this verse at the beginning of your family prayer this week. Thank God for all God has done for your family.
- Distribute a sheet of paper to each family member. Ask each person to list ten blessings in his or her life. After a few minutes of reflection, ask each member to share some of his or her blessings. Then make a list of family blessings.






