Dear Parishioners,

My friends, sometimes the most constructive help we can offer someone is the room to “fail,” giving them the space to make mistakes without ridicule, criticism or second-guessing and supporting them as they struggle to make sense out of what has gone wrong.

Jesus provides such “space” for the woman he meets at Jacob’s well: a safe, nonjudgmental space where the woman can see her life honestly and completely, where she is able to confront her failings and brokenness and begin to turn her life around. Rather than reject her or condemn her, Jesus calls forth from her a sense of faith and joy that enables her to re-make her life and become the means for others to experience that same grace and joy.

In fact, all of us who have encountered Jesus are called to the work of reconciliation (not judgment), to reach out and bring forth from one another the good each one of us possesses as a son and daughter of God. In so many ordinary ways we can bring forth new life and hope in Christ if we focus on healing rather than punishing, in teaching rather than criticizing, in rebuilding rather than rending.

“How can you, a Jew, ask me, a Samaritan woman, for a drink?” The question the Samaritan woman asks Jesus reflects the wall that exists between her and Jesus: centuries of distrust and animosity between their two peoples.

Because He is Who He is, Jesus’ engaging her in conversation begins to tear down that wall. They find common ground in the simple charity of a drink of water.

My friends, because we call ourselves Christian, we are required to dismantle the obstacles and tear down the barriers that divide us from others, to move beyond the differences among us to embrace the dignity we all share as human beings created in the image and likeness of God.

Unlike the woman at the well, the “Samaritan” women (and men) who live among us dare not ask us for recognition, assistance, justice or compassion.

May we resolve this Lent to respond to them with compassion and respect — without their having to ask.

May God our Father strengthen you on your Lenten journey.



## Readings of the Week

### **Reading I:** Exodus 17:3-7

*Is the Lord in our midst or not?*

- In the Exodus reading, the Israelites grumble about their experience in the desert.
- Their thirst represents Israel's real question, "Why did God make us leave Egypt?"
- Yahweh responds graciously to the needs of the people.

### **Reading II:** Romans 5:1-2, 5-8

*We are at peace with God through Christ.*

- The wonder of God's free gift of salvation in Jesus is subject of the passage from Paul's Letter to the Romans.
- God responds to our need with compassion and mercy.
- God's love is poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit.

### **Gospel:** John 4:5-42

*Whoever drinks the water I give, will never thirst again.*

- In the story of the Samaritan woman, Jesus uses water as a symbol of God's revelation and God's Spirit.
- The exchange between Jesus and the woman causes conversion to take place.
- The woman identifies Jesus several times, each time with greater understanding. First, he was a Jewish man, then a prophet, and finally she makes a comment about the Messiah.

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- The Samaritan woman felt free to change because she felt that Jesus loved and accepted her. As a family, talk about how we feel when someone in the family wants us to change. Why does it help when you know that the one who is making the request loves you? Why is it important for us to affirm the good we see in one another? How does knowing Jesus help us to change for the better?
- Use the story of the woman at the well to show how Jesus accepted the outcast. Discuss with your family: Who are the outcasts and strangers who live in our community? What does it mean to welcome them, and accept them for who they are?




