Letter From Sister Sheila Murphy

Dear Parishioners:

This year the church celebrates the feast of St. Joseph on March 20th. St. Joseph is the beloved patron of the Sisters of St. Joseph who taught for many years at St. Ann School and Wildwood Catholic High School. Our Congregation was founded in France in 1650. The original group of six young women was under the sponsorship of Jean-Pierre Medaille, S.J. Thus the spirituality that developed among the group reflects a strong Jesuit influence. The women would profess simple vows, dress as the women of their day and live in community. They would have no specific work but would do all they could to address the "miseries of the day." To support themselves they made lace and taught others to do the same. By the time of the French Revolution, 150 years later, the sisters had spread to 12 dioceses. However, the revolutionaries confiscated their convents so the sisters either returned to their homes or left France. A few were sent to prison, some to the guillotine. The Congregation was disbanded.

In 1807 the Congregation was refounded and spread through France and beyond. In 1836 the first Sisters of St. Joseph came to the United States and settled near St. Louis. In 1847 some from this group came to Philadelphia and eventually to Wildwood.

The spirituality of the Sisters of St. Joseph is practical. It posits that God is present and active in our world and our lives. Thus we can discover God's will for us by paying attention to our hearts and responding in loving service to others. We can all strive to approach life with this mindset.

The mission of the Sisters of St Joseph states: We live and work that all people be united with God and one another. To this end we desire to imitate God's inclusive love, to be one with Jesus in His self-emptying love, to develop a discerning contemplative heart and to love the "dear neighbor" without distinction. It is about becoming the love we contemplate.

Of course we do not do this perfectly. All of us are on the path together. To paraphrase the poet...one's reach must exceed one's grasp - or what's a heaven for?



There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:


These are days of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter season.


