## *From the Desk of Thomas Piro - Seminarian*

Dear Parishioner,

As I am sure you have noticed, today is a unique day during the season of Lent. The priest is wearing rose instead of violet. The reason the priest wears rose is to remind the faithful that we are quickly approaching the culmination of the liturgical year, the Paschal Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday) and Easter Sunday. As we continue to prepare ourselves through prayer, fasting, and alms-giving, let us rejoice in the Lord.

Rejoicing in the Lord is something very interesting. To rejoice in the Lord requires an interaction, an encounter with him. In today's gospel, we see the man born blind encounter Jesus. After his healing in the pool of Siloam, the man is able to see the world, yet he has not seen Jesus after the healing. People question him and all the once-blind man knows is this man named Jesus came and laid hands on him and put clay on his eyes and told him to go wash at a specific place. The man knows he once was blind and now he can see. Jesus goes and finds the man, and engages with him again. Through the second encounter, the blind man comes to see and believe.

The most concrete reality in this gospel is the blind man encounter Jesus Christ more than once. Jesus entered his life in the beginning and changed it forever. Jesus, however, does not leave his life after the healing. Jesus seeks him out again. Jesus never stops entering our lives; Everyday, Jesus desires an encounter with each of us.

Jesus may desire to encounter us every day, but we must allow ourselves to be receptive to the encounter. As we approach the end of the season of Lent, perhaps we can reflect on an encounter we had with Jesus Christ. What was it about that encounter that changed you? If you can't think of a particular encounter, perhaps you can join us for the celebration of the Paschal Triduum and allow yourself to encounter him.



## Readings of the Week

### Reading I: 1 Samuel 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a

*David is anointed king of Israel.*

- Saul the first king anointed by Samuel is rejected by God for disobedience.
- God sends Samuel to Bethlehem to anoint Saul's successor. Samuel anoints David.
- The first reading is a story of seeing. God sees David as no one else sees him.

### Reading II : Ephesians 5:8-14

*You are people of the light.*

- The passage from Ephesians expands on the division between the sightless and the seeing.
- Those who believe in Jesus are children of light.
- With Christ they have been raised from the darkness of death and live in the light of Christ.

### Gospel : John 9:1-41

*Jesus gives us sight.*

- At the start of today's Gospel story of the man born blind, the disciples believe that sin is the cause of the man's blindness. When Jesus gives the blind man sight, both the disciples and the blind man move from darkness into light.
- The Pharisees accuse Jesus of sin because he healed the blind man on the Sabbath. The man with new sight however sees more clearly, he calls Jesus a prophet.
- The Pharisees refuse to believe; they are truly blind.

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Use a candle to communicate to your children the light of Christ. Pass the candle around to each family member. Have family members take turns telling the person holding the candle, what good things they see in him or her.
- As we continue our Lenten journey, evaluate your family resolutions of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Are our Lenten practices helping us to see the light of Christ in others? What Lenten practices help us see the light of Christ in ourselves?
- Have a family discussion about seeing the needs of each other in the family. Have family members share what they need and whether anyone sees those needs. Discuss how seeing each other with "eyes of faith" can help build family unity.
