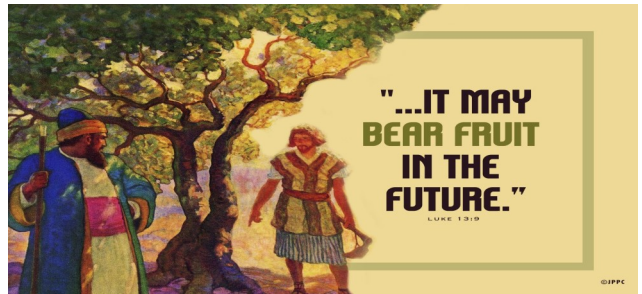

My dear friends in Christ,

“Time flies” is an often-used expression, and the older we get, the more quickly time seems to fly! Already we are beginning the third week of Lent and our Scriptures speak of God’s telling Moses that He has heard the complaints and cries of His suffering people and His desire to free them. And in the epistle, Paul reminds us that the ROCK of strength is Jesus, while in Luke, Jesus’ message, “if you do not repent, you will perish...”

And my question, for myself, and all of you is: Do I really believe and trust that God hears my cries and wants to free me, that Jesus is my Rock and that Lent is the best time to look at my life and to repent and return to the Lord? In the light of the ominous threats and suffering in the Ukraine at this time, and in light of the mounting concerns over the economic struggles of so many, as well as, the growing anxieties about the safety of the whole world, do I take seriously this time of Lent to pray, to fast (from food, gossip, complaining, self-centeredness, etc.) and to give alms (service, time, talents, money, etc.)? Or have my days returned to the pre-Lenten routines? Time does fly! But we can give that extra effort to slow ourselves down, to not fly with it, but to walk humbly, quietly, prayerfully with our God. Like Moses, we are standing on “holy ground” and NOW is the time to listen to the Lord, to believe in God’s love for us and to repent and return to the Lord with our whole heart. Let’s do it! With God’s grace we “can do all things in Him Who strengthens us”. Let’s pray for one another!



Muy queridos amigos en Cristo,

“El tiempo vuela” es una expresión frecuentemente usada, y con mas años, con mas rapidez parece que el tiempo vuela. Ya estamos comenzando la tercera semana de la Cuaresma y las Escrituras hablan de Dios diciendo a Moisés que ha escuchando las quejas y gritos del pueblo sufriente y Su deseo de liberarlos. Y Pablo en su carta nos recuerda que Jesús es la Roca, mientras en Lucas leemos el mensaje de Jesús, “si no se arrepienten, perecerán...”

Mi pregunta entonces es esta: ¿Realmente creo y confié que Dios escucha mis llantos y quiere liberarme? ¿que Jesús es mi Roca y ¿que la Cuaresma es el mejor tiempo para examinar mi vida, arrepentirme y regresar al Señor? En la luz de las amenazas siniestras y el sufrimiento del pueblo Ucranio en estos días, y en la luz de las preocupaciones crecientes sobre las luchas económicas de tanta gente, así como también, las ansiedades grandes sobre la seguridad del mundo entero, ¿tomo en serio este tiempo de Cuaresma para orar, ayunar (de la comida, de los chismes, de las quejas, del egoísmo, etc.), y dar limosna (servicio, tiempo, talentos, dinero, etc.)? ¿Han vuelto mis días a los de antes de la Cuaresma? ¡El tiempo vuela! Podemos esforzarnos para decelerar, no volar con el tiempo, caminar humildemente, en silencio, en oración con nuestro Dios. Como Moisés, estamos parado sobre “tierra santa” y AHORA es el tiempo para escuchar al Señor, para creer en el amor de Dios, arrepentirnos y regresar al Señor con todo el corazón. ¡Hagámoslo! Con la gracia de Dios “podemos hacer todas las cosas en El que nos fortalece.” ¡Recemos los unos por los otros!

## *Readings of the Week*

### **Reading I:** [Exodus 3:1-8a, 13-15](#)

*God's name is: "I AM WHO AM".*

- In the first reading from Exodus, Moses questions God's call.
- God's answer, "I AM who Am" has lead believers to contemplate the meaning of God's reply to Moses.
- Today's passage shows that even in the moment of personal revelation, God remains a mystery.

### **Reading II:** [1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12](#)

*What is written about Moses is to help us.*

- The reading from 1 Corinthians is Paul's meditation on the fate of the people who were delivered in the Exodus.
- Not all of the people who were freed remained faithful to God.
- Paul stresses that being delivered from sin through Baptism is not enough. We must continue to turn back to God when we have turned away.

### **Gospel :** [Luke 13:1-9](#)

*Jesus tells us to repent.*

- Today's Gospel story was Jesus' answer to those who judged others through the theory of retribution.
- Humans cannot see enough to judge God's purpose in events.
- The parable illustrates God's patience concerning human sin.

### **Weekly Readings Reflection**

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Lent provides us with an opportunity to change our hearts. Encourage family members to spend quiet time listening to God this week. Reflect on the question: Are we living as God intended, or do we need to change some things in our life? Take time later in the week to discuss the changes family members need to make in their lives.
- Talk about how God has helped your family grow this past week. Look at the plants in your home or yard. Do they need pruning or replanting or fertilizing to grow stronger? Do this as a family, remembering our own need for conversion and growth.
- Plan to attend your parish Lenten Reconciliation service as a family.

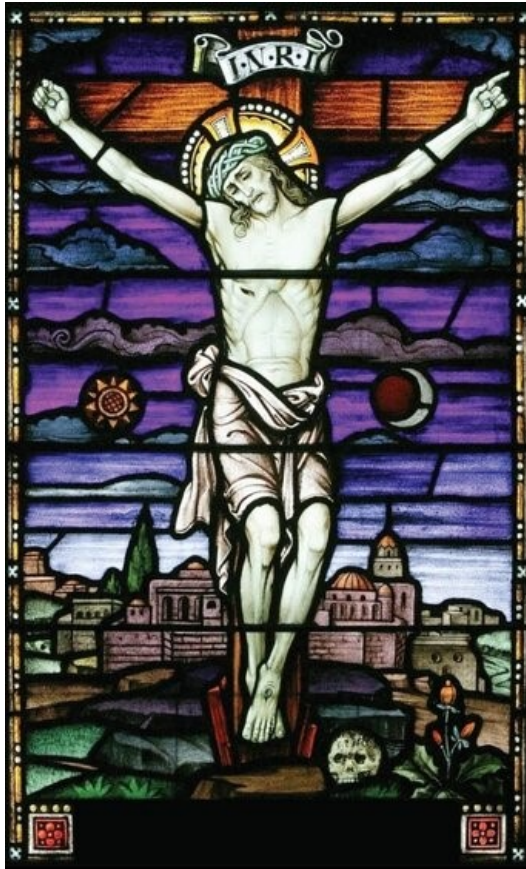

### How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

### Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.
