# Letter From AnnaMae Muryasz

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Lent; the half way point to Easter. Formerly in the church this Sunday was known as "Laetare Sunday" since its mood and theme was one of hope and rejoicing that Easter was near. Today with the exception of wearing the Rose colored vestments by the priest this Sunday it is the same as all the Sundays of Lent. The Rose colored vestments are worn today to show the Joy and anticipation at the nearness of Easter.

As a parish we have been praying the stations; hearing brief talks on the "The Seven Last Words of Jesus"; taking part in the Ecumenical Soup Suppers on the Island; and attending penance services. Next weekend along with the Diocese of Camden and Bishop Dennis Sullivan we will be collecting canned goods for the needy. In the back of the church today you will find bags with a list of needed items on them. Please take one home and place the items in the bag and bring the bag back with the items next weekend to church. Please leave the bag in the back of the church in the foyer to the left or the right when entering. Thank you in advance for your participation in this most worthy cause.

In our First reading today we see that Samuel anoints David as future King of Israel. With this anointing the Lord came upon David and blessed him as the chosen future King with the gifts of the Spirit. David walked in the LIGHT. In our Second reading we are reminded to live in the LIGHT. For it is in the LIGHT that we find all that is good and right and true. It is in the LIGHT that Christ will shine on us. And as Christ shines on us so we must allow Christ to shine on others through us.

In the Gospel reading today we find that there is a great deal of ritual that are in the actions of Jesus. In the past Jesus had healed others of blindness with a simple touch but in this case he mixed mud, water, and spittle in order to heal the man. Today we notice that the man's eyes were really opened and that includes the eyes of his soul. Clearly Jesus was intent on healing the total person of the man. This man was so totally healed that he lands on his knees, worshipping Jesus.

The greatest way we can do good for others is not by giving them items but in helping them to appreciate what they already have. It is good to affirm others and make them feel both loved and worthwhile. Many people have grown up with a poor self-image, and they just cannot see the good in themselves. This is another form of blindness, and it is a blindness in others that any one of us can have power to heal. The most certain proof that the Spirit of God lives in us is our willingness and ability to affirm and bring a blessing to other people. HOW WILL YOU BRING OR BE A BLESSING TO OTHERS THIS WEEK??????



## Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:


These are days of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

## Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

## **Easter Duty Obligation:**

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter season.
