Weekly Readings Reflections

4th Sunday of Lent

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- The Gospel reading for Sunday is one of the most familiar stories in the Bible. Read with your family the story of the return of the prodigal son, Luke 15:1-3, 11-32. After the reading, list the steps of reconciliation identified in the story.
- Prepare your family's favorite meal. Before the meal, ask family members to share stories about a time when they were grateful for the gift of forgiveness that someone in your family offered them.
- Agree, as a family, to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation together with the Parish family during Lent. Check to see that everyone is comfortable and remembers how to participate in the sacrament. Plan a family treat after the celebration.

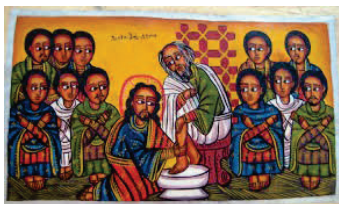
Holy Hour of Intercession

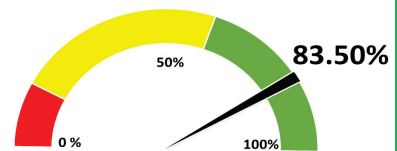

Liturgy Corner ...learn something new or maybe become inspired !

How are "the Now" days of Lent going for you? Mathew Kelly in his book *The Biggest Lie in the History of Christianity*, speaks of the great possibility of our days being filled with "a holy moment". He says "a holy moment" happens when we open ourselves to God--- we make ourselves available to Him- it's the moment we set aside what we feel like doing in that moment and for one brief pause - we do what we prayerfully believe God is calling us to do that brings out " the best-version-of-myself." That's "a holy moment"!

The conscious/deliberate schedule we made for lenten prayer time, the acts of self-denial and the selfless giving of ourselves to others, the reflective spiritual reading the sacrificing to get to Mass during the week and being attentive to "Thy Neighbor/family" weave the threads that create **a holy moment**. They are the ground from which a holy moment springs. A holy moment needs openness to God, time and effort on our part, prioritizing, and action. It **is habit forming**, but the joy **a holy moment** gives to God, others, and self is the Gospel. May you have Good News this week and the next and the next...
