Dear Parishioner,

May the peace, hope and love of the Risen Lord be with you! Our 40 days of preparation have ended as we entered into the most solemn liturgy of the Liturgical year, a three day service that includes the telling of the central mysteries of our faith. This liturgy culminates in the celebration of the central cause of our joy as Christians, as announced to us by the first witnesses, Mary Magdalene, Peter, John and the other Apostles, that he is risen, he lives again!

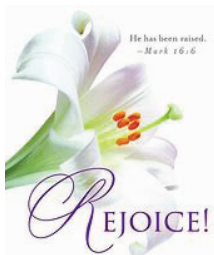
Christ's resurrection puts an end to two of the greatest enemies of humanity, sin and death. Evil is not the last word because the goodness of God has triumphed. Injustice is defeated by the justice of God in raising his Son from the dead. Sin, too, is overcome by the forgiveness of God in the death of his Son. Finally, death, too, is conquered by the resurrection of Christ! In Christ we know that there is a certain future, a sure hope of justice, peace, joy and new life. Nothing can destroy the plan of God for humanity. What will happen at the end of time is the reign of justice, peace, righteousness, joy and love in the Holy Spirit.

At the Easter Vigil we lit the symbol of the Risen Christ, the Easter Candle from the "new fire" as we processed into the darkened church. This light, like the moment of Jesus' resurrection, pierces through the darkness and illumines our path, through a world marred by the darkening effects of sin and hopelessness. This light is to be kept burning brightly, as we admonish families at baptisms when passing on to them the baptismal candle lit from the Easter Candle. At our baptism the celebrant instructed our parents and sponsors: "This light is entrusted to you to be kept burning brightly. This child of yours has been enlightened by Christ. He/She is to walk always as a child of the light. May he/she keep the flame of faith alive in his/her heart. When the Lord comes, may he/she go out to meet him with all the saints in the heavenly kingdom!"

What Jesus showed us in the moment of resurrection is the ultimate victory over sin, hatred and suffering, even death. We should rejoice, for as St. Paul tells us in the resurrection of Christ we need not live our lives in fear, not even fearing death, for death, the last enemy of humanity has been overcome. Yes we can leave the past behind and strive each day to be one with Christ in his death and resurrection. As St. Paul said, "I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus." (Phil 3:13) In the light of the resurrection, we must now live our lives confidently and courageously. Easter means that we are sure of ultimate victory and guaranteed of everlasting life, of joy, love and peace with God!

I would like to wish you all a most Blessed Easter! May the joy of this day fill your hearts and lives with blessed assurance. Thank you for living out your Easter faith in the fulfillment of your ministerial duties to our parish through service, generosity and support. I join my fellow co-workers in Christ, the priests, sisters and parish staff in thanking you for the opportunity to serve you in Christ. May the light of Christ that you received on the day of your baptism continue to burn brightly as it illumines your path to eternal life in God! Happy Easter!

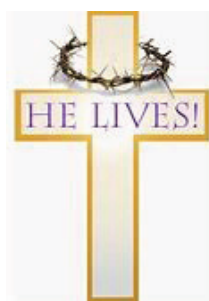

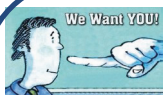

NEW PREP SCHEDULE CLASS REGISTRATION NOW OPEN

SCHOOL YEAR: Classes will be held the first three (3) Sundays of the month (October to May, excluding January), from 9 to 10:20 a.m. at CTC/EEC (former St. Ann School), 2901 New Jersey Ave., Wildwood, followed by attendance at 10:30 Mass, St. Ann Church.

SUMMER INTENSIVE CLASSES: Classes are held daily from 8:30 a.m. to noon, July 30 to Aug. 10 (ten sessions). Classes are held at WCHS/CTC building, 1500 Central Ave., North Wildwood.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Preparation to receive First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation requires a two-year commitment to PREP classes as well as classes especially designed to strengthen the understanding of the sacraments. Attendance at Retreats, Service Projects and Parent meetings is also required.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SUMMER INTENSIVE AND YEAR-ROUND STUDENTS:

There will be three (3) class meetings held throughout the year; one in Advent, Lent and Pentecost. Students may select any two (2) of these.

PREP will hold two (2) Family Fests where the entire family will come together to share a meal, have class time, and celebrate prayer. These are required.

Additionally, families will be asked to choose two (2) other faith-filled activities at their convenience

All these experiences are considered part of the curriculum and failure to comply risks not being promoted to the next level the following year.
