From the Desk of Kevin Quinn - Parish Administrator

This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday. We remember Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem more than 2,000 years ago. We will receive palms and participate in the Passion through Matthew's Gospel. We are not alone in this celebration. Hundreds of millions of Christians around the world celebrate much as we will here in Southern New Jersey.

A simple Google search can provide a description of Palm Sunday...According to Catholic Online:
"Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week, and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before he was crucified. Palm Sunday is known as such because the faithful will often receive palm fronds which they use to participate in the reenactment of Christ's arrival in Jerusalem. In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect. Palm branches are widely recognized symbol of peace and victory, hence their preferred use on Palm Sunday. The use of a donkey instead of a horse is highly symbolic, it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war. A week later, Christ would rise from the dead on the first Easter".

That's a great illustration of Palm Sunday, but it leaves something out — the subtle message and quiet lesson that we should all remember. The message is this: Although Palm Sunday reminds us of the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem that kicks off the Easter narrative, it should also remind us of the fickle and tenuous nature of life. The story ends as a bittersweet paradox with a memorable life lesson.

I think all of us wonder, "why" when life sharply turns against us, and that's where the lesson of Palm Sunday comes in. Bad times, at some point, come to everyone, no matter who you are. After all, look at what happened to our Lord: one day, Jesus is welcomed into Jerusalem as a king, a hero, with thousands shouting hosannas and singing his praises. Four days later, he is arrested and treated like a criminal, tortured and mocked, with many of those who cheered him now calling for his death.

If Christ can go, in less than a week, from triumphant hero adored by thousands to death in one of the most horrible manners ever devised by man, should we be surprised when we sometimes see our life turn from good to bad so suddenly? We like to think we can control what happens in life, and for a great deal of the time, that may be the case. But as Christ's entry into Jerusalem shows us, none of us are really in control no matter how much we think we are. Life can change overnight. And often enough this turn is out of your control.

If you struggle with the feeling that you need to control everything in your life or even if you feel like you are losing control of your life...Remember this: God loves you and He wants to help you! Through scripture, prayer, a listening ear, and a thankful heart, you can have gain victory over your need to control. As you hand more over to Him, you will find peace and clarity on God's will for your life. He promises it.



Readings of the Week

Reading I: Isaiah 50:4-7

The Lord God is my help.

- The reading from Isaiah is part of the third Servant Song.
- The song communicates the servant's belief that, no matter how cruel or indifferent people are, God's justice will prevail.
- Suffering is never an end in itself.

Reading II: Philippians 2:6-11

Your attitude must be Christ's.

- Paul's letter to the Philippians was written while Paul was in prison in Rome.
- Despite being imprisoned, Paul expresses confidence and joy in the Lord.
- Paul stresses that our salvation is Jesus' kenosis, the Greek word for Jesus' "emptying" of himself from glory.

Gospel : Matthew 26:14-27:66

The passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- The Passion Narrative is among the earliest traditions to be handed down in written form.
- In Matthew's passion account, all the events proceed according to God's will as revealed in the Hebrew Scriptures.
- Jesus, the servant and Son of God, has poured himself out to overcome humanity's separation from God.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Take time to evaluate your Lenten observance and to plan for the celebration of the Triduum. Have family members reflect on what they need to let go of in order to fully rise with Christ.
- To make this Holy Week special, turn off the television set for the entire week. You may want to put a crucifix or a picture of Jesus on your table. Put a palm branch with it. Have a family discussion about what each person can do to grow closer to Jesus this week.
- Make crosses from the palm branches and put them in a prominent place in your home. Ask each family member to reflect quietly on the following: Is there something that I need to give up in order to be closer to Jesus? After a few moments, join hands and pray the Lord's Prayer together.
