

Dear parishioners,

The readings for the 3rd Sunday in Easter encourage us to truly believe in the resurrection of Jesus Christ and to accept his love. In the gospel the risen Jesus appears to his disciples and helps them understand his death and resurrection.

Knowledge, you see, isn't based simply on the acquisition of facts, information, and data. True knowledge is seeing things based on wisdom and understanding. Religious knowledge is seeing reality based on the gifts of the Holy Spirit, particularly His gifts of wisdom, understanding, and knowledge.

My friends, encountering Jesus is about recognizing God's love living among us. This is a wonderful passage from Luke, because Luke lets us know that Jesus seeks us out when we are troubled with doubts about ourselves, the world in which we live, our painful lives, all of these things. When we don't know what to do, when we feel maybe that even God has abandoned us, it is Jesus who comes to us. And he just appears.

Indeed, He appears in their midst and the first words he says are: "Peace. Peace be with you."

What kind of peace?

Truth be told, the peace that Jesus speaks of is the shalom that we all seek in the depths of our heart, in other words, a harmony between God and man, a harmony that is so deep that there is only caring and mutual forgiving, sharing, and a new world that God really intended gradually comes into being.

My friends, the trouble with the world today is not that it's bad or not that it's good. The trouble with the world today is it's so cluttered. It's so cluttered that people have forgotten how simple life is and this is what Jesus has come to teach us.

Do you want to know what life is?

Love one another. Care for each other. Sacrifice for each other. And then you will know that God is with you and will carry you forth, and you need to be afraid of nothing, not even death, for there is no death in God, there's a transition from life to life.

May you soon have some time to make your own Emmaus time. And may you come to recognize Him not only in the breaking of the bread but in all those other moments where God tries to break in on our time and walk with us as we face all of the remarkable events life hurls at us.

For without His presence with us we certainly will feel depressed and defeated.

Peace be with you. Do not be afraid!

May God our father give you grace and peace!

Reading I: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

God raised Christ from the dead.

- In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter explains that Jesus is the fulfillment of the ancient messianic promises.
- Jesus, the Messiah, who died and was raised to new life, brought a new life of peace and right relationship with God.
- Through Jesus, God's merciful love is available to all those who seek it.

Reading II: 1 John 2:1-5

Whoever keeps God's word has love made perfect.

- The first part of the second reading reminds believers that sin still exists in the world.
- Believers must walk in light because God is light.
- Christ, who lives in a totally loving relationship with the Father, is also the Advocate who pleads our cause with the Father.

Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

He stood in their midst.

- The author of today's Gospel attempts to tell us that Jesus' resurrection involves the whole person, body and spirit.
- After his resurrection, when Jesus eats with the disciples, they recognize him in the breaking of bread.
- Life in Christ is a life of forgiveness and peace.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

- Ask each member of your family to discuss one way in which the Resurrection of Jesus makes their relationship with God stronger.
- Discuss how it is sometimes hard to see Jesus' presence in certain situations that occur in our world. Give examples of specific situations. In what way could family members see Jesus' presence in similar situations in the future?
- Make a list of life events that have occurred in the history of your family that were examples of God's mercy. Discuss why that mercy was not deserved. Does God decide that one person (or persons) deserves mercy over another?
