Dear Friends,

Today's gospel caught my attention because it seemed not tell the whole story. Where was the part about Thomas? Luke doesn't mention Doubting Thomas. So I went hunting for him. And here he is in John 20:24-29... "Now Thomas, one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. The disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

"The disciples were in the house again and Thomas was with them. Jesus stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" He said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." Thomas said, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."


"...blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." This is our faith; a faith for today; a faith that sustains our hope and confidence in God in this present moment. And how is that...that we hold fast to Him whom we have not seen?

We believers are not fools. We know Him. We experience Him. We trust Him. We who are made in His image and likeness are called to see God in one another. This can only happen by putting our faith into action. We are called to be His hands and feet and heart for one another. St. Teresa of Avila sums it up in her beautiful prayer: "Christ has no body now but yours; no hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes with which he looks compassion on the world...Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good. Yours are the hands with which he blesses all the world...you are His body."

Most likely, many others have shown Christ to us. Someone taught us about Him and helped us see Him in our everyday. Someone prayed with us and stayed with us when we were the doubters. Thomas had met Jesus personally, walked with Him, talked with Him, even ate with Him and yet he almost missed the glory of the Resurrection. The doubting Thomases we meet depend on us to show them who Christ is. Are we willing to show them the love, compassion, forgiveness and vulnerability that He asks of his followers? Are we willing to bear the cross for one another? As Christians, do we have a choice? Go, be Christ's hands and feet and eyes and heart.







NEW PREP SCHEDULE CLASS REGISTRATION NOW OPEN

SCHOOL YEAR: Classes will be held the first three (3) Sundays of the month (October to May, excluding January), from 9 to 10:20 a.m. at CTC/EEC (former St. Ann School), 2901 New Jersey Ave., Wildwood, followed by attendance at 10:30 Mass, St. Ann Church.

SUMMER INTENSIVE CLASSES: Classes are held daily from 8:30 a.m. to noon, July 30 to Aug. 10 (ten sessions). Classes are held at WCHS/CTC building, 1500 Central Ave., North Wildwood.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Preparation to receive First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation requires a two-year commitment to PREP classes as well as classes especially designed to strengthen the understanding of the sacraments. Attendance at Retreats, Service Projects and Parent meetings is also required.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SUMMER INTENSIVE AND YEAR-ROUND STUDENTS:

There will be three (3) class meetings held throughout the year; one in Advent, Lent and Pentecost. Students may select any two (2) of these.

PREP will hold two (2) Family Fests where the entire family will come together to share a meal, have class time, and celebrate prayer. These are required.


