

Message from Rev. Joseph D. Wallace, Pastor

Dear Parishioner,

As I thought about sharing with you the message of joy that Easter promises us all, I felt a bit ambivalent. I felt a bit diminished in my own joy as the echo of the sad events that caused us all embarrassment and doubt this past year concerning the sex abuse crisis in the Church. I also thought of the embarrassment, doubt and grief that the first disciples must have experienced over the brutal death of their rabbi Jesus of Nazareth. That is until that moment when the faithful women went to the tomb of Jesus and were met with the angelic message, "Why do you seek the living one among the dead?" Once they realized the full meaning of this proclamation their joy was restored and renewed.

In the midst of the Church's present troubles we too should be turned from gloom to joy in the sure knowledge and belief that the forces of darkness in the human heart that lead to death have been conquered. The choices and actions of some of our number that led to the misery and death of some of our fellow spiritual travelers seems to have grasped the Church in a death grip. But the victory of good over evil that unfolded in the mystery of the Resurrection of Jesus is the promise of life even in the face of death. The power of sin that leads to death is swallowed up in the victory of Jesus Christ at the moment of the Resurrection. Therefore we do not seek the living among the ashes of death.

Our faith in Resurrection means we believe God will always bring us out of suffering. With so much hatred, violence and betrayal in the world, our faith tells us that God's love will conquer all sin. In this we place our hope and find our joy!

Our loving support of our parish, diocese and universal Church helps to dispel the darkness, the shadow side of our humanity and proclaim to one another and to the world that he lives and through his Spirit he is renewing, restoring and transforming the world. Your loving support, especially through your generosity in our Catholic Strong and House of Charity appeals allows us to carry on our perennial mission of proclaiming the good news of Jesus. It is a message that our ears and all ears wants and needs to hear! Thank you so much for all you do to support the Church – spiritually, personally and financially. You can be certain that God will reward your goodness.

I am thankful for the ministry and dedicated work of Fr. Steve, Deacon Nick, Kevin Quinn, Mary Vey, Jonathan Delgado, Donnamarie Black, Anna Landis, Pat Monaghan, Jim DiFazio, Paul Abbruscato and the numerous ministers and volunteers who help me to bring the joy of the Gospel to you all.

I pray that the power of the Resurrection which still pulsates in the Church will turn our darker moments into the light and joy that that angelic message uttered long ago challenges us even to today, "Why do you seek the living one among the dead?"

Weekly Readings Reflections

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- Easter is a time to celebrate new life. Plan an Easter egg hunt for all ages of the family. Fill plastic eggs with candy and put slips of paper containing uplifting Bible verses in some of the eggs. Have anyone who finds an egg with a Bible verse open it up and share what is written on the slip of paper.
- Make Easter bread together as a family. Before placing the bread in the oven, thank God for sending Jesus and for all of the blessings bestowed on your family.
- Color Easter eggs as a family and discuss their meaning. Point out that an egg is hard like a tomb but it also gives new life. As the activity is in process, discuss what is new in your life.



Emerging and Strengthening

As we celebrate Easter, the greatest event/miracle of all time *_the resurrection of Jesus from the dead - Jesus has overcome sin and death and has come back to life,* we begin seeing among his followers- not yet called "Christians"- the emerging and the strengthening of their relationship, beliefs, and faith in the person of the resurrected Jesus

Jesus knows full well that relationships take thought, time and work so He lovingly and thoughtfully takes the next 50 days to help His followers firm up and strengthen relationships that began just about three years prior.

So too with us- let us continue to put aside those quiet, reflective spaces that we have woven into our noisy, busy lives and continue to collaborate/talk with Jesus. In these quiet moments go out with Mary Magdalene to look for Jesus. Be with Thomas in the upper room and whisper with him, "My Lord and my God." Walk with the disciples to Emmaus where they beg Jesus ".Stay with us for awhile." And go fishing with Peter, walk on the water with him, and whisper "It is the Lord." as you both walk toward Jesus in faith.

As the 50 days of Easter Time pass back into Ordinary Time, these quiet, reflective, spirit filled moments help us to hear Jesus' final question to Peter and to us- - "Do you love me?" May we with Peter answer from the bottom of our hearts, "Lord, you know all things. You know that I love You."
