From the Desk of Deacon Rich - Pastoral Associate

Dear Parishioners,

The Gospel for the third Sunday of Easter is the famous story told of the disciples on the road to Emmaus. It tells of two followers of Christ who, sad and disheartened, left Jerusalem the day after the Sabbath, the third since his death, to go to a nearby village called Emmaus.

Along the road, the risen Jesus came up beside them, but they did not recognize him. Sensing their dejection, he explained on the basis of the Scriptures that the Messiah had to suffer and die to achieve glory. Then he entered a house with them, sat down at table, blessed the bread and broke it, and then they recognized him. But he vanished from their sight, leaving them full of wonder before the broken bread, a new sign of his presence.

An interesting fact is that archaeologists have not identified the location of Emmaus with any certainty. Of this fact, Pope Benedict observed that "Emmaus is really everywhere, the road that leads there is the path of every Christian, indeed, every human being."

On our own faith journeys, the risen Jesus is a traveling companion who "rekindles in our hearts the warmth of faith and hope and the breaking of the bread of eternal life."


My sisters and brothers in Christ, the account of the disciples traveling to Emmaus reminds us that Jesus meets every one of us on our own individual faith journeys where we ARE ... but Thanks be to God, He does not leave us there! By the grace of God's Spirit, we move onward, confident of God's love and mercy.

Pope Benedict commented further: "Still today, Jesus speaks to us in the Scripture; still today Jesus gives us his Body and his Blood. The road to Emmaus becomes the way of a purification and maturation of our belief in God: the encounter with the risen Christ gives us a deeper faith, one that is authentic, tempered, so to speak, through the fire of Easter, a faith robust because it is from the Word of God and the Eucharist, not human ideas."

Concluding his reflection on the Gospel, Pope Benedict said, "This beautiful evangelical text already contains the structure of the Mass: in the first part listening to the Word through the Scriptures; second in the Eucharistic liturgy and communion with Christ present in the sacrament of his Body and his Blood. Nourishing ourselves in this twofold meal, the Church builds itself up and is renewed every day in faith, hope and charity."

Readings of the Week

Reading I: Acts 2:14, 22-33

My heart has been glad.

- In the first reading from Acts, Peter tells the story of Jesus.
- For the Israelites, the Resurrection is a sign that Jesus is the “anointed one”.
- Today’s passage reveals that Jesus is both Lord of heaven and the Messiah sent to save Israel.

Reading II: 1 Peter 1:17-21

It is through him that you are believers.

- Today’s letter from 1 Peter aims to encourage Christians to remain faithful in the face of hardship.
- The Israelites’ journey through the desert is compared to the journey of the Christian life.
- For Christians, salvation is ours when we follow in the footsteps of Jesus, sufferings included.

Gospel : Luke 24:13-35

Were not our hearts burning within us as he spoke?

- In today’s Gospel, a stranger joins the disciples as they journey to Emmaus.
- It was not unusual for a person living in the region at the time to invite a stranger to be their guest and share a meal.
- The stranger/guest in today’s Gospel suddenly becomes the host, and the disciples receive from him the Bread of Life.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Talk to your family about the disciples’ journey to Emmaus. Discuss reasons why the disciples did not recognize Jesus even though he was close to them. Apply this reading to your own lives. As a family, discuss ways that you can make an effort to be more aware of Jesus’ presence in your lives.
- In the Emmaus story, the disciples did not fully recognize Jesus until they shared a meal with him. Why is mealtime an important time for your family? When have you experienced Jesus’ presence at a family meal?
- Every Sunday we have an opportunity to experience Jesus in the Mass. Make Sunday’s liturgical celebration special by going to Mass as a family and having a special breakfast or lunch after Mass.




