

Your prayers are answered A testimonial April 2024

At Notre Dame de la Mer we have several groups dedicated to prayer alone with intentions and names of those we pray for. Every morning before daily Mass the Rosary and intentions are said. After every morning Mass the Chaplet of Divine Mercy is said. Every Wednesday night at 7pm Scripture, Liturgy and Rosary are said. Every other Saturday the Men's group says a Rosary with supplication. In all of these, we pray for those names who need God's mercy along with our own intentions, we ask for God's mercy.

What I want to share, and you read with your own eyes, is God's answer. He always answers whether we hear it or accept it. My brother-in-law (my big sister's husband), called us awhile back to share bad news he received. He was diagnosed with kidney cancer. His family and my family were very saddened.

Here is the rest of the story!

**"Dear Brothers and Sisters in Prayer:**

**My name is Tom and I am Chuck Mirarchi's brother-in-law. Chuck asked you to include me in your prayers as I had been recently diagnosed with a malignant growth on one of my kidneys. This diagnosis hit all of us like a pile of bricks. We were not expecting anything like that. Chuck and Beth were the first people we told and Chuck immediately said he would add me to your prayer list. That night, as I lay in bed with a million thoughts going through my head, I began my evening prayers. I had not even got to the part where I was going to ask our Lord to grant me his mercy when I felt as though hands were touching me. No just touching me but internally massaging my kidney! I fell asleep knowing that Christ had graced me with his touch.**

**At my wife's urging, a few weeks later we met with another urologist who specialized in cancers. He looked at the same CAT Scan and told me point blank that I did not have cancer. We were dumbfounded. He said that an MRI would be more definitive than the CAT Scan and if we wanted, he would order it. The subsequent MRI results showed no cancer!**

**Prayer works and I am so thankful for all of your prayers. I will forever be grateful to you and you will always be in my prayers.**

With the testimonial from Tom, I wanted all to know God's hears us and answers us. There are other examples I can share, like the young lady we prayed for who was in kidney failure for 2 years and recently had a donor and is doing well. Then there is the gentleman who has had lymphoma for over a year and his treatments are helping him, and yet another woman with a bacterial infection, near death and now is close to a full recovery, and many more good stories.




