Dear Parishioners,

Today we hear the gospel story of the vine and the branches. A vine is an excellent image of the church. Its single root is in Jesus and its mission is to grow to the ends of the earth. In today's gospel, the words of consolation and encouragement that our Lord spoke to his Apostles on Holy Thursday night, were intended to console and encourage all his followers for all time. They continue to encourage and console us today as we persevere on the road to heaven. With all the attractions and temptations of the world, we know that at times this is not an easy road to follow. In our world today these attractions have been multiplied by the increased comforts, pleasures and means of self-indulgence, which science and technology have put in our reach.

Having the ordinary comforts of life and the possession of some of this world's goods is not wrong. Unfortunately natural temptation is to get more and more of these comforts and riches, and the point is soon reached where this becomes the only purpose in life. When we find ourselves going down this path, it is very important to turn to our prayer life. The goal of our life of prayer is to increase our awareness that Jesus lives with us always. Prayer is more than a dialogue with God. Prayer is a lifting of our minds and hearts to God so that God might dwell and act within us and through us; just as Jesus taught his disciples that his relationship with them would not end after his death. This unity between Jesus and his disciples is the basis for their ability to continue to do the work that he began. Similarly, Jesus' presence with us through the gift of the Holy Spirit enables us to continue the work of love and reconciliation that he began. We observe many people who act in ways that show their commitment to serve their neighbor. They show this by feeding the hungry, caring for the sick, giving shelter to the homeless and alms to the poor. These actions become acts of Christian discipleship when they are motivated by our relationship with Jesus. Christ has promised to remain beside us during life if only we stay close to him. While we remain healthy branches of the vine, we will be on that vine to heaven.

The commitment we give to Christ is strengthened by our life of prayer and nourished by the Eucharist. Through the Eucharist, Jesus dwells in us, remains with us, and transforms us so that we might bear fruit in his name.

Please pray for the youngsters of our Parish Family who will say, "Amen, yes I do believe!" as they receive the Holy Eucharist for the first time next weekend at the 10:30am Mass. Let us also keep one another in prayer always so that we may forever be nourished by the vine and the vine grower.

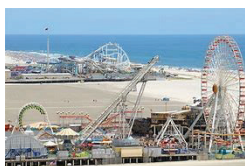

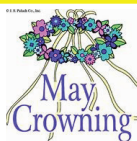

### NEW PREP SCHEDULE CLASS REGISTRATION NOW OPEN

SCHOOL YEAR: Classes will be held the first three (3) Sundays of the month (October to May, excluding January), from 9 to 10:20 a.m. at CTC/EEC (former St. Ann School), 2901 New Jersey Ave., Wildwood, followed by attendance at 10:30 Mass, St. Ann Church.

SUMMER INTENSIVE CLASSES: Classes are held daily from 8:30 a.m. to noon, July 30 to Aug. 10 (ten sessions). Classes are held at WCHS/CTC building, 1500 Central Ave., North Wildwood. **Registration closes Sunday, June 17, 2018. Classes limited to 20 students per class.**

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Preparation to receive First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation requires a two-year commitment to PREP classes as well as classes especially designed to strengthen the understanding of the sacraments. Attendance at Retreats, Service Projects and Parent meetings is also required.

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SUMMER INTENSIVE AND YEAR-ROUND STUDENTS:

There will be three (3) class meetings held throughout the year; one in Advent, Lent and Pentecost. Students may select any two (2) of these.

PREP will hold two (2) Family Fests where the entire family will come together to share a meal, have class time, and celebrate prayer. These are required.

Additionally, families will be asked to choose two (2) other faith-filled activities at their convenience

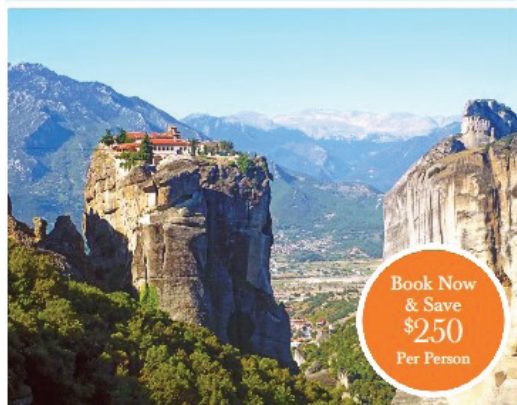
