My Dear Friends,

Today's scripture readings are quite similar. In the first reading, was given by St. Peter on the feast of Pentecost. This sermon gives the same message as the Gospel of today does: God has raised up Jesus of Nazareth who was crucified. This is the foundation of our creed which we say each Sunday; when we celebrate and remember Jesus' death and resurrection and break bread as he asked us to do. We celebrate and nourish our commitment to Jesus' universal mission, in our universal Church. Each Eucharist causes us to be challenged to embrace the whole world just as the love of Christ embraces the world. So, do we truly recognize Jesus in the breaking of the bread? It is important for each of us to remember that Easter isn't over when all the eggs are eaten. It lasts for seven weeks, during which time we should be praying for the Spirit to come and fill our hearts with the peace and joy of our Redeemer, who rose from the dead and still lives in the hearts of each of us.

The two disciples who leave Jerusalem and journey to their home in Emmaus have realized a terrible loss. They had given up their homes and work to follow this Jesus, whom they expected, would bring all mankind to the reign of God. But their hopes died with Christ at his crucifixion. They were walking away, not only from his death, but also, from his resurrection. The mystery of God's ways are forgotten by these two disciples, even though Jesus had told them, many times, that in Jerusalem, he would suffer, die, and be raised up. They were blinded by what was presently happening to them; so they handled their confusion by going back to the place that they had originally come from. Emmaus was seven miles from Jerusalem. Some authors tell us that this walk represents: "a whole process of moving from loss to new life, from blindness to faith." Let's recall the last time we have experienced our hopes die? And who and how were our hopes brought back to life?

During 50 years of telling Jesus' story, the early Christians began to develop insights which the written gospels proclaim. "Remember how he told you while he was still in Galilee that the Son of Man would be handed over to sinners and be crucified and on the third day rise again." Then they remember. Are we blinded to the presence of God at work in our lives?

In the Emmaus story, the risen Jesus becomes present to the two disciples first through interpreting the scriptures and then through the breaking of bread. This is reenacted for us each time we attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. By extending hospitality to the stranger, the disciples welcomed a guest who became their host. But, as soon as the two disciples recognized Jesus, he vanished. Their recognition was the beginning of their faith experience and they, then, began to put together a new vision. They met Jesus in the breaking of the bread because they wanted to hear more and so they invited him to dinner. Let's ask ourselves: which role is most transforming to us that of guest or that of host? Do we ask our guests to stay? Do we recognize the Jesus in them?


