Dear Friends,

The Merriam-Webster Dictionary defines “ripple effect” as: “a spreading, pervasive, and usually unintentional effect or influence”. Ripple effect is also known as the compound effect, butterfly effect or the domino effect. It is as simple as where you make one little change and it starts to “trickle” into or effect other parts of your life.

A couple was traveling home through a driving rain storm. They both noticed a woman waiting for a bus in an uncovered bus stop. The wife told her husband to go back and give her their umbrella. The husband was reluctant because it was an expensive umbrella. She persisted and he turned around and gave the woman the umbrella. The woman smiled and thanked them profusely. They knew instantly that they did the right thing. This simple act of kindness moved the husband. He purchased umbrellas and left them in his car just in case someone needed one to shelter themselves from the rain. As he distributed them, he just said...pay it forward. Today as a result of that single event, a non-profit foundation was born. This foundation actively supports six inner city grammar schools. Their mission statement in part says: “We believe that a single action can make a difference in the community...”.

A dying man decided he wanted to keep his Christmas tree up year long. Each month would be a different theme to correspond with holidays, birthdays, anniversaries. January was his birthday month. Family and friends sent ornaments for the tree (he never asked for anyone to help with the ornaments). There was so much joy and happiness in decorating the tree. In February he received ornaments to celebrate Valentine’s Day from not only family & friends but from friends of family & friends. Many were from people he never met. March and April trees were filled with decorated...both purchased and homemade ornaments. The May tree is right around the corner. The ripple effect is also a multiplier, an action taken by one person will affect the action of others.

Last May the parish honored our 90+ parishioners with a luncheon. Our Forever Young and Men’s Group partnered with us to make the event memorable to both our guests and us. On Wednesday, May 24 the parish is sponsoring the 2nd annual luncheon. Two additional parish ministries have requested to be part of this beautiful event. Once again... the trickle-down effect. 

Readings of the Week

Reading I: Acts 2:14a, 36-41

You must reform and be baptized.

- In today's first reading, Peter poses some important questions about the meaning of life to the Jews assembled in Jerusalem.
- From Peter's perspective, those who had yet to recognize that "Jesus was both Lord and Christ" were a corrupt generation.
- In asking the Jews to believe that Jesus was "Lord and Christ," Peter was really saying that Jesus is God and Messiah...

Reading II: 1 Peter 2:20b-25

By his wounds you were healed.

- The reference to Isaiah's Suffering Servant in today's first reading, points to the example of Christ.
- Jesus Christ was truly innocent and when he suffered, he did not oppose with force.
- This message was important for the Christians who were suffering persecution at the time for living as followers of Jesus.

Gospel : John 10:1-10

I am the gate.

- The Gospel today portrays Jesus as the gateway through which we enter the Church.
- Besides drawing on a common image from everyday life at the time of Jesus, today's Gospel evokes several passages from the Hebrew Scriptures.
- In Ezekiel 34, the prophet reveals that God is the shepherd of the sheep. The author of today's Gospel understands that God has become the shepherd in Jesus.

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Choose a picture of Jesus to hang in your home. Have a special blessing when you hang the picture. Pray Psalm 23 together.
- As a family, identify some of the voices that try to drown out Jesus' voice in today's culture. Discuss how these voices can lead us astray.
- Who are the ones in need in your family, extended family, neighborhood, or community, for whom you can be a shepherd? In imitation of Jesus the Good Shepherd, help meet these needs in a caring way.
- Have family members reflect on the following question: How does your family take care of you and help you grow? On the same sheet of paper list all the things your family does for you. Talk about how the love of family reminds us of God's care and love for us.
