





Dear Parishioners,

Today we hear our Lord by way of metaphors which accomplish a lot of things more than using plain language. Metaphors evoke our imagination and feelings. 'We, the branches, draw our sustenance from our connection with Jesus, the vine. We cannot survive if we are cut off from him.'

Indeed, we are expected to bear much fruit, for the benefit of others. 'The Father prunes to make us bear fruits, many fruits, and not just some fruits. You see, God wants something excellent and remarkable, God does not want that mediocre results.'

Today we are being challenged to "remain" in Jesus, not to betray him, not to live independently from him, or to attach ourselves to another plant / person / teacher... to fill ourselves with a different blood (non-Christian culture, non-Christian belief, non-Christian community, non-Christian God and values)

Those of us who call ourselves Christian are called to establish connections (relationships). 'And so, we improve our relationship with God so as to be more productive along with our fellow believers. In fact, we cannot do much if we are isolated from others. You see, if we cut ourselves off from our community, we will disappear in nothingness. Truth be told, cutting off from the vine, from Christ and the Church, means no involvement, detached from the life of the community, no commitment, no growth, no glory.'

My friends, The Eucharist is the sacrament of our relationship with God. In the Eucharist, we connect ourselves with Christ and vice versa. Through the participation of the Eucharist, we connect ourselves with one another. When we come to the Eucharist, we fulfill our vows to be holy. Indeed, in this Eucharist, Jesus comes to nourish us.'

For sure, we cannot be productive in the vineyard of the Lord if we are cut off from the Eucharist. My friends, He will be with us, but it is our turn to walk the way he walked, to care the way he cared, to love the way he loved.

And this is the way, this is the way that the Kingdom of God shall gradually take over the whole world. As believers, let's always remain as productive branches of the Vine!

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Adoro Te Devote

Not to sight, or taste, or touch be credit hearing only do we trust secure; I believe, for God the Son has said it- Word of truth that ever shall endure.

If you bring a friend who is not catholic and did not go to a catholic school, to eucharistic adoration or Mass, what would they say about the small round host? They will say it seems like a piece of bread- nothing more and nothing less. If they were to taste the host, they would say, with confidence, that it is simply a piece of bread. As Catholics, we know this is not true. We believe that this host is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. This host is the Word made Flesh.

St. Thomas Aquinas notes that our faith in the Eucharist is not through our tasting and touching. It is through the words of Jesus. Jesus proclaimed four times “I am the Bread of Life” in John 6. He is “the living bread that came down from heaven” (John 6:51). The Jews suggested that this was metaphorical, and Jesus denied that this is metaphorical. He persists in confirming that we must eat the flesh of the Son of Man. On the night of the Last Supper, Jesus instituted the Eucharist. At that moment, the apostles knew what he meant when he said, “unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you” (John 6:53).

Do we suppress God’s omnipotence? Do we “downplay” his power? If we were to explain to someone that this “host” is the same person who died on a cross and rose from the dead, they would say, “that is impossible. It’s bread.” Is it impossible? Science may say so, but the angel Gabriel at the Annunciation told Mary that “nothing will be impossible for God” (Luke 1:37). Do we believe Jesus’ words that this is his Body and Blood, or do we trust our observations and conclusions?




