Dear Parishioner,

Both our second reading from the First Letter of John and our gospel reading from John on this Sixth Sunday of Easter contain the word “love” nine times. Why? “Because love is God” and “God is love.” We can only love because we are first loved by God. God always loves us, even when we sin God still loves us. God created us out of love. God gave his commandments because he loves us. God allows us to suffer the consequences of our sins because he loves us. We have to face the consequences to motivate us to change. Jesus says, “If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love.” Keeping God’s commandments begins in obedience on our part but finds a firm foundation in our recognition of God’s love for us so that we know we can trust that his commandments are good for us. Our obedience in doing what Jesus commands shows that we trust in him as our friend. Jesus tells us what the greatest love is. “No one has greater love than this, to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.”

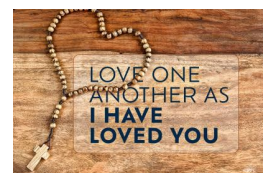

Each time we postpone a task to tend to the needs of another, we show ourselves to be on the path to following the example of love shown to us by Jesus. If we are people who have practiced showing our love for others with generosity, we will also be people who are willing to lay down our lives for those we love.

On Sunday May 12<sup>th</sup>, Thomas Piro will assist the celebrant for the first time as Deacon at the 8:30am Mass at The Church of the Assumption. Please join us for this special Mass and a light reception following in Msgr. Kelly Hall.

Please keep both Thomas Piro and Timothy Mulranen in your prayers as the transitional diaconate implies that the intent of these two men is to be ordained as priests next May 2025. Please pray for continued vocations to the religious life and may God bless them and all seminarians!

## Readings of the Week

### Reading I : Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48

A person from any nation is called to follow Christ.

- In the first reading, it is evident that the early Church found it hard to accept that God's plan for salvation was not limited to the Jews.
- The vision in Peter's dream prepares him for his meeting with Cornelius, a Gentile.
- Peter baptizes Cornelius and his household, and he declares that God is not partial but loves all people.

### Reading II : 1 John 4:7-10

Let us love one another.

- The reading from 1 John is part of a series of statements that end with the crucial reminder that love comes from God.
- The author wants to point out how much God loves us.
- God demonstrated the extent of his love by sending his Son to give his life for us.

### Gospel : John 15:9-17

So I have loved you.

- Today's Gospel continues the theme of love with the message that God has loved us, so therefore, we must love one another.
- Love demands all we are, to the point of giving up life for the sake of another.
- God is the source and object of our love.

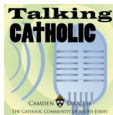

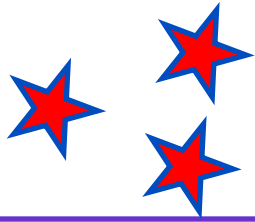

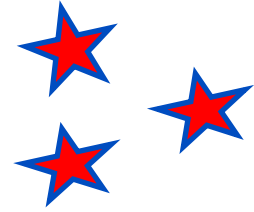
