## From the desk of Donnamarie Sexton, Parish Catechetical Leader -

Dear Friends,

Happy Mother's Day!

This year on Mother's Day I would like to talk about a special gift we can give to Mary our Blessed Mother. We all know one of the best ways to a loving mother's heart is to be kind to her child. One of the easiest ways for us to accomplish this with Jesus is through adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Adoration of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is an important part of our Catholic faith and a great way to honor and worship God. It's a way to acknowledge God's presence, deepen one's relationship with Jesus, and experience spiritual renewal. Adoration can also lead to rest, focus, and a deeper understanding of God's love.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a time for heartfelt prayer, reflection, and spiritual activities while in the presence of the Eucharist. Reading Scripture and reflecting on its meaning is a powerful way to connect with God's word during adoration. Engaging in spiritual reading, such as the lives of saints or inspirational books can be a nice way to spend your time with Jesus. You could read the Catechism of the Catholic Church or other theological texts for a deeper understanding. Praying the rosary, liturgy of the hours or any other devotional prayer is also a good way to spend your time in adoration. Some may choose to write in a prayer journal or listen to praise and worship music through head phones. Just simply sitting in silence in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament can be a profound and meaningful experience allowing for a deeper connection with God, a time to listen to the Holy Spirit, and to examine one's conscience. It's also a time to ask for forgiveness, to pray for others, and to express love for Jesus.

The point is there is no right way or wrong way to do adoration. Jesus would just love to have you sit and visit with him while he is truly present to you in the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist. And what makes Jesus happy makes his mother happy. Honor Mary this year by dedicating some time with her son in adoration.

Notre Dame de la Mer Parish has adoration every Monday-Thursday 9am-1pm and Friday 9 am -3 pm at Assumption Church. We are in need of people to sign up to sit with Jesus on a regular basis. Please pray on it and consider giving Jesus one hour a week. If you cannot commit to one hour a week maybe do one hour a month. Whatever you can do Jesus will appreciate the time alone with you. ## Readings of the Week

#### Reading I : Acts 13:14, 43-52

Many became believers.

- The reading from Acts describes the first missionary outreach of the early church.
- Paul and Barnabas were sent fourth by the Holy Spirit to spread the good news.
- When they were rejected by the Jews, Paul and Barnabus decided to bring the message to the Gentiles.

#### Reading II: Revelation 7:9, 14b-17

The Lamb at the throne will be their shepherd and will lead them to springs of living water.

- Today's passage from Revelation was part of a grand vision in which all God's faithful were gathered.
- The faithful "survived the time of great distress", which probably refers to persecution of the early church.
- God's faithful became united with Christ in his death and were sustained in life by him.

#### Gospel: John 10:27-30

I give my sheep eternal life.

- In the Gospel, Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd.
- The passage goes on to describe the relationship between Jesus and his Father.
- John stresses the unity between Jesus and the Father.





## Saint of the Week:

## St. Anselm of Canterbury, Bishop and Doctor, (1033-1109)

Anselm was born in Italy and acquired a love of learning from his mother. He knew at an early age that he wanted to become a monk, and did so in 1060. He preferred the contemplative life, but after serving fifteen years as Prior, Anselm was chosen as Abbot of Bec in 1078. He composed many theological and philosophical writings during this time. He gained a reputation as a holy and scholarly man. William the Conquerer, on his deathbed, sought consolation from Anselm. Anselm eventually served as Archbishop of Canterbury the last sixteen years of his life.

**Feast Day**: He is honored by an optional memorial on the anniversary of his death, April 21.

**Anselm's message today:** Thrust into positions which he did not seek and tried to decline, Anselm nevertheless served well and earned the respect of all but a few of his flock.






