Dear Parishioners,

The day has come. Yesterday, May 17, 2025, Bishop Joseph A. Williams ordained me to the sacred priesthood of Jesus Christ. The past eight years of seminary have concluded, and now I begin a new era on my journey of faith as a priest ministering to God's holy people.

Today's gospel, however, reminds me of the foundation of my vocation—God's initial love for me and his command to love one another. What is this "love" Jesus speaks about? How do we show this "love"? Many of us have different definitions, experiences, and perceptions of love. In fact, the Scripture expresses the complexity of love by using four different words to describe it (*storge*, *philia*, *eros*, and *agape*). The command Jesus gives us today is the strongest form of love, the *agape* love. *Storge* involves familial love. *Philia* pertains to friendships. *Eros* is a passionate love. *Agape*, though, is total, sacrificial, unconditional self-giving. This command to "love one another" means to give everything to another without any cost. This is the love Jesus commands us to practice.

During the ordination rite, those to be ordained prostrate themselves on the floor as the people sing the litany of the saints. The gesture of prostrating, lying face down on the floor, symbolizes the total self-gift, the *agape* love, that I give to the Lord and to the people he has entrusted to me. I have given myself completely to the service of God and his people unconditionally. Many may question why a young man may choose to do this, and the answer is clear. Christ showed me his *agape* love by dying on the cross for me, and has called me to live out this command of total self-giving love through the priesthood.

The command to love one another, however, is not reserved for priests. This is a command to every single person touched by Christ's *agape* love! It is not an option. Married couples live *agape* love by giving each other totally to their spouses and children. Religious brothers and sisters live *agape* love by dedicating themselves to their charism, whether it be serving the poor, teaching, or going to the peripheries to preach the Good News of Jesus Christ. How is Christ asking you to exercise *agape* love?

Indeed, the day has come. I will begin to minister to God's holy people as his priest. I ask you to pray for me, pray that I may always exercise *agape* love to those I serve. Please also pray for more young men to lay down their lives for the Lord and his people. Know that I will always keep the Notre Dame De La Mer Family in my prayers, and know of my gratitude for the *agape* love you have shown me all these years. *Oremus pro invicem!*

Reading I : Acts 14:21-27

They assembled the church and gave an account of all that God had done with them.

- The reading from Acts describes the return of Paul and Barnabas to Antioch to report on the success of their missionary efforts.
- They help the new Christians organize their small communities.
- The Christian communities are encouraged to persevere in spite of the suffering that their new faith might bring them.

Reading II : Revelation 21:1-5a

God will wipe away all the tears from their eyes.

- The vision from Revelation is a description of God's final victory over evil and the establishment of the kingdom in its fullness.
- Jerusalem, the city of God and God's people, comes from heaven and is made new by God.
- The new community is represented by love for God and for one another.

- The Gospel presents the heart of Jesus' message: "Love one another as I have loved you."
- Before the passage, Judas left to betray Jesus.

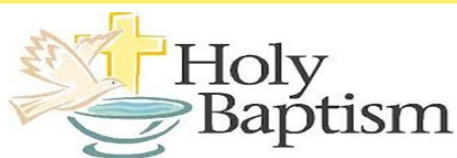

Saint of the Week:

Athanasius, Bishop and Doctor, (293-373)

Athanasius became the bishop of Alexandria in Egypt at the age of thirty. He lived at a time when many people believed false teachings that Jesus was not really the Son of God. As bishop, Athanasius defended the doctrine of the Trinity. Because of his outspokenness, he was sent into exile—not once, but five times over the course of his life. During these times he lived in hardship but spent his time writing, praying, and encouraging other Christians.

Feast Day: The Church celebrates his feast day on May 2.

Athanasius' message today: Athanasius kept the faith when it would have been easy to give in to the heavy pressures which he was under. There are a lot of false gods in our times: more money, a bigger house, a fancier car. Our culture would have us put these things into our lives at the cost of our faith.

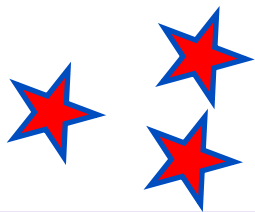

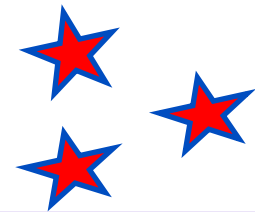
