

From the Desk of Deacon Tom Piro

Dear Parishioners,

After 7 long years of formation, Bishop Sullivan ordained me to the Sacred Order of Deacon last Saturday in Sea Isle City! This is a huge milestone in my journey to the priesthood, and I would like to thank you, the faithful of the Wildwoods, for all your prayers and support. I thank Fr. Mazz for being the celebrant last Sunday at my first Mass as a deacon. I thank Fr. Tom, Deacon Nick, and Deacon Rich for being there to support me as well. Thank you also to all who came to support me at the ordination and the 8:30 am Mass last weekend and those who helped prepare for the Mass and reception following the 8:30 am Mass.

When handing me the Book of the Gospels, Bishop Sullivan declared I am now a herald of the Gospel. As a herald, I have been tasked to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ at every moment of my life in word and deed. Knowing myself, I am very weak and cannot do this on my own. Aware of my weakness, I take great comfort in the solemnity we celebrate today—Pentecost. On this day, we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles, which enabled them to go out and proclaim the Good News to all nations. Through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, the faith spread worldwide. The Holy Spirit perpetually inspires the Church today and gives her the gifts needed to touch the hearts of those who hunger for the Prince of Peace.

Readings of the Week

Reading I : Acts 2:1-11

All were filled with the Holy Spirit.

- In the Acts of the Apostles, the story of Pentecost occurs on the fiftieth day after Passover, the day after seven Sabbaths.
- The strong wind recalls the mighty wind that swept over the waters at creation and the breath of life that God blew into the human being.
- The tongues of fire at Pentecost symbolize a new call and a new covenant.

Reading II : 1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13

There are different gifts, but the same Spirit.

- In 1 Corinthians, Paul describes the unity of Christians who are filled with the Holy Spirit.
- They are one body, breathing with the same breath.
- The gifts of each contribute to the life of the whole.

Gospel : John 20:19-23

As the Father sent me, so I send you.

- The Gospel reading portrays the timeless events of Jesus' resurrection and the descent of the Spirit.
- Jesus breathes on the disciples, creating them anew, and proclaims the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Filled with the Spirit, the disciples continue to spread new life and remedy the separation caused by sin as they forgive sins.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

- Gather as a family this week to celebrate Pentecost. Explain that with the coming of the Holy Spirit, we celebrate the birthday of Jesus' Church. Prepare and decorate a cake. Have each family member come forward to light a candle on the cake and respond: "As the Father sent me, so I send you."
- Sometimes we need help and guidance to live as Jesus taught us. For your family prayer this week, pray for the gift and guidance of the Holy Spirit. Use this prayer: Come Holy Spirit! Fill our hearts with the power of your love.
- Talk about each of the gifts of the Spirit: wisdom, understanding, right judgment, courage, knowledge, reverence and awe in God's presence. How do you see these gifts at work in your family?



HEALING THE PAIN OF ABORTION ONE WEEKEND AT A TIME
