From the Desk of Deacon Nick—Pastoral Associate

Dear brothers and sisters in the risen lord,

Pentecost is all about stepping out and putting into practice the words of the risen Jesus found in Acts 1:8...before His Ascension into heaven.

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

It is about stepping out of our comfort zones into the real world in which we live, carrying with us the gospel of Jesus Christ and aiding people’s encounters with the risen Lord.

You see, Pentecost, sees the world as envisioned by God: that is, not a divided world of boundaries and borders and flags and uniforms, but of sisters and brothers who share the dignity of being made in the Creator’s image. That’s the miracle we celebrate today.

My friends, what happens in the story of Pentecost is more than a miracle of instantaneous translation: the Spirit of God breaks through the barriers of language and culture to create a community of empathy and respect, bringing different peoples together as the one people of God.

Indeed, it’s the Spirit of God that enables us to listen as well as speak, to see from the perspective of another in order to find a common path to travel together, to find solutions to problems that incorporate the gifts of all for the good of all.

Truth be told, It’s not this building’s walls and roof that make us a church; it’s not even our physical proximity to one another that defines us as a faith community. It’s that unseen but very real Spirit of God that opens our hearts to God and to one another, that transcends the limits of our physical being to embrace and be embraced in the heart of God.

In the Pentecost event, the Spirit of God enables Peter and the community of disciples to break down the barriers of language and culture and nationality to reveal God’s peace in the midst of all these visitors to Jerusalem and to realize God’s vision of an earth that serves as home to one human family, united in peace, respect and justice.

On this Pentecost, we celebrate the beginning of our Church — a company that Jesus gathers together to remember his life and celebrate the love of God manifested in that life by calling forth the gifts each one of us possesses for the good of all.

On Easter night, in Jesus’ “breathing” upon the assembled disciples, the new life of the Spirit, the community of the Resurrection, the Church, takes flight. That same Spirit continues to “blow” through our own Church today, giving us wisdom and hope that enables us to mirror that Gospel in our struggle to live lives of selfless caring and generosity.

May God our Father give you Grace and Peace!

Readings of the Week

Reading I: Acts 2:1-11

All were filled with the Holy Spirit.

- The Pentecost mystery reverses the Tower of Babel.
- In today's first reading, the many visitors to Jerusalem are foreigners, thus they are hampered by the diversity of their languages and regional dialects.
- Rather than being confused by the different languages, each person hears God's deeds proclaimed by the disciples, in his or her own language.

Reading II: 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13

There are different gifts, but the same Spirit.

- Today's second reading underlines the necessity of unity in the Holy Spirit.
- The gifts of the Spirit are for the building up of the Church.
- However different the gifts, when members of the Church use their gifts to complement the gifts of others, they form the one Body of Christ.

Gospel: John 20:19-23

As the Father sent me, so I send you.

- In today's Gospel, the disciples pass from a state of fear to joy.
- Jesus breathes his Spirit on them and he commissions the disciples to continue his mission on earth.
- Enlivened by the Spirit, the disciples are empowered to make the presence of God known throughout the world.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- On Pentecost, God poured out upon the world the gift of the Holy Spirit. Gather your family outdoors and point out the force of the wind. Discuss with your family how the Holy Spirit is like a mighty wind. Talk about how the gift of God's Spirit strengthens your family. End your gathering with a family hug.
- Write each of the names of the fruits of the Holy Spirit on a slip of paper (charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, chastity), and place the papers in a bowl. Each morning this week have the members of the family choose a slip out of the box and make an effort to carry out that behavior throughout the day. In the evening have members return the slip to the bowl, evaluating how they did during the day.
