**June 4, 2017
Pentecost Sunday**



Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost which is known as the “birthday of the Church.” On this day of celebration we call to mind God’s Love and we remember that “God so loved the world that he sent his only Son so that we might have life.” A **life** that will provide joy and happiness, a life that will call us to be the best that we can be when we are doing the will of the Father. God promised that the Holy Spirit would be with us to help us to speak of our faith and to live our faith if we but ask for his help. This joyful news reminds us that we have “a song to sing”. A song that is rooted in the beliefs of our faith and a song that is felt in the deep recesses of our hearts and a song to sing from within the “gift” of who God shaped us into being. We need to remember to sing of the goodness of the Lord as we walk along life’s path with the Lord. And we need to remember to **SMILE** because we know the **LORD**.

In the readings today we hear of the energy passed down from God to the Apostles. We also hear about the work of the Spirit in the early Church, and the power of the Spirit given to the Disciples by God to continue the mission of Jesus. It is difficult for us to imagine the Holy Spirit since a clear image is never given of him. In some readings we hear that the spirit appeared in a powerful wind from heaven; or that there were tongues of fire that appeared over the heads of the apostles in the upper room. Most traditionally the dove is used to represent the Holy Spirit. Although we do not have a definitive image for the Holy Spirit we should not forget him because Jesus never forgot him. He even promised on the eve of his passion to send the Holy Spirit to the Apostles. Secondly, we need to remember the Holy Spirit because he was an example to the early Christians. He made a difference in their lives. Before the coming of the Spirit they were timid and afraid, when he descended upon them in a miraculous confusion of wind, fire and speech, they were utterly transformed wanting to eagerly speak of and proclaim the message of God.

On May 25, 2017 Bishop Sullivan confirmed 42 of our parish members with the gift of the Spirit. Their lives were touched by the Spirit and new gifts were imparted to them from the Spirit. Their lives were forever changed by the gifts of joy, love, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, trustfulness, gentleness, self-control and so many more. The Spirit is now able to work with their better instincts in accomplishing good for themselves and for others. The Spirit is never idle and is always ready to accomplish good for the Kingdom of God through us. May the Spirit do great things through each of us and through these members of our parish. God bless each of you for all that you do in the name of the Spirit of God.




