From the desk of Rev. Ernest Soprano, Retired Assistant

Dear Parishioner,

Though I have helped out in the Community of Notre Dame de la Mer for nearly a year, I am happy to introduce myself as a retired Pastor Priest. I live in the Crest and have enjoyed celebrating at both Parish Churches. My friendship with your Priests has allowed me to renew my acquaintance briefly with Fr. Tom Kiely returning to this Diocese and with Fr. Mazz whom I've enjoyed knowing over many years. I've celebrated 46 years a Priest on May 25th. My father once referred to it as "Christmas in May" for my family, and indeed it has been a bounty of blessings! In my first 20 years I served as Associate in Haddonfield two times, Cherry Hill, Runnemede, Gibbstown, and Turnersville, and Bishop Guilfoyle's secretary. Since 1996 I was Pastor at Landisville, Vineland and N. Cape May. We were a family of 5, our Parents Ralph & Jennie, my sister Amelia now in N. Cape May, and my deceased sister Louise, who lived near Pt. Pleasant Beach, NJ.

I enjoyed my last assignment nearby the shore that I chose to retire and reside at the seashore and have enjoyed it tremendously.

Already its going to be three years living here full time. Each year the months go more quickly, so I chose to look at this month of June and the celebrations of our Faith in which we can be renewed.

It's a busy month liturgically. We celebrate the Ascension of the Lord on the first day of June. His work completed, His mission fulfilled, Jesus returns to the Father, not to abandon us, His Church, so He sends the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit to protect, guide and enlighten the growing number of followers over the centuries and into our own lives. This feast of Pentecost is personalized in our Confirmation.

We are never alone, our God is always with us. Now having received the Holy Spirit, our next Sunday, June fifteenth, celebrates the Most Holy Trinity. Now the Lord has revealed the mystery of One God, in three divine Persons. This is what we profess in our Creed every Sunday. To unite us together we feed upon the Body and Blood of our Savior on the next Feast on June 22 and acknowledge the Life Death and Resurrection of Jesus and our participation in the Trinity when consuming the Body of Christ.

Who best to demonstrate this Church at its beginning in the human response to so great the mysteries of our Faith than St. Peter and St. Paul. Each, in different ways represents the depths of humanity than when Peter was forgiven and then leads the Church at his time and over the ages. From St. Paul we receive the instructions He wrote to the young communities and learn from His teachings at every Mass.

This is quite a busy month in faith. May it guide us daily at graduations, holidays, weddings, funerals and even in our retirements. Cherish and care for your faith, and that of your family. It will help us during our lifetime and help us all arrive safely home to be eternally with God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Readings of the Week

Reading I : Acts 2:1-11

All were filled with the Spirit!

- For the people of Israel, Pentecost originally had been a festival celebrating the wheat harvest and later it was associated with the covenant at Sinai and the exodus event.
- To remember this, Jews went to the temple in Jerusalem on the feast to offer sacrifices to God. That is why Jews from all parts of the world were gathered there in Jerusalem when the Spirit came upon the disciples.
- In today's story of the first Christian Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descends on the disciples and the Church is born.

Reading II : 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13

We are one Body in Christ.

- In his first letter to the community in Corinth, Paul stressed that God's gifts were given to serve and build the community.
- Paul compared the Christian community to the human body.
- A person becomes a member of this body in Baptism.

Gospel : John 20:19-23

Receive the Holy Spirit.

- In the Gospel of John the word Peace appears five times and three of them occur in the form of Jesus' greeting, "Peace be with you".
- After his greeting in today's passage, Jesus breathed new life on the frightened disciples, and they received the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- The disciples were entrusted with the mission of forgiving sins.

Family Reflection Corner

Theme: God's breath – the Holy Spirit – gives us true life and peace.

Breaking Open the Word

Suggested text for faith sharing: *Today's Gospel*

Step One: Listen to the Word

As you hear this reading, what words or phrases strike you? What in this reading touches your heart? What lingers in your memory?

Step Two: Look into Your Life

Question for Children: Jesus tells us that we need to forgive to have peace. Name one way that you can forgive a friend or classmate.

Question for Youth: St. Paul tells us that we all have unique gifts for the good of others. What is special about you? How can you use those gifts to help others – friends, family, strangers?

Question for Adults: Even as working disciples of Christ, we are given the gift of peace. How do you experience this gift, and how do you share it with others?

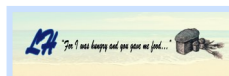

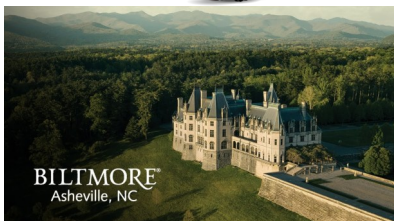

Mary Magdalen de Pazzi, Virgin, 1566-1607

From an early age Caterina loved prayer and practiced penance. She also performed works of charity for the poor. She developed a love for the Blessed Sacrament. She received her First Communion at the age of ten and was sent to a convent at the age of fourteen and entered the Carmelite convent of Santa Maria degli Angeli in 1582. She took the name Maria Maddalena (Mary Magdalen). She became quite ill, took final vows, experienced forty consecutive days of ecstasies, then a miraculous cure. She carried on with her duties, but suffered from terrible depression. She proposed a renovation of the Church by way of letters to the pope, cardinals, and bishops. She died of consumption after suffering physical and spiritual pain.

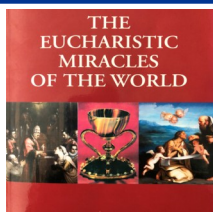

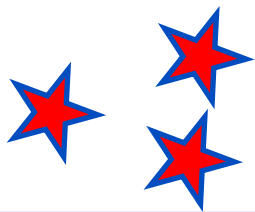

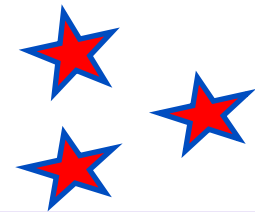
