10th Sunday in Ordinary Time**



Dear Parishioner,

This Sunday's gospel tells us about the family of God and Jesus' family. At first glance, there appears to be opposition between the relationship between Jesus, his family from Nazareth (of flesh and blood) and "the new family circle" that of the twelve and the other disciples. Let's look carefully at this text: First of all, we see Jesus' family coming to seize him saying, "He lost his mind!" Because the crowd was so great in number and so intense, it was impossible for His family to reach Jesus, so they stayed outside and asked for Jesus. The disciples were gathered in the house. They said nothing, they did not criticize, they made no claims, but they listened to the teachings of Jesus. They were all around him, sitting in a circle, they already formed a group, an "assembly", a church. Returning to the episode of Martha and Mary, we understand that the disciples have chosen the best part, they are already doing the will of God listening to his Messenger; they are already on their way following Jesus.

Here, Mark emphasizes the difference, the separation that exists between his clan, his family, his friends, the disciples and his new family. In Jesus' day, family values were sacred. This is why Jesus does not pit his relatives against his disciples, but he uses words of family relationships such as brothers, sisters, and mother to make it clear that spiritual words are as important as kinship and even, that they go beyond that: "He who loves his father, or his mother more than Me, is not worthy of Me."

It shows that family ties, no matter how important they are, are not absolute in relation to the message of the Kingdom of God. How do we become a true follower of Jesus? We have to look at Mary. We know that she not only gave birth to Jesus according to the flesh and nourished him but, she was a good mother. She was above all a true believer. She followed Jesus, and she was attentive to his words.

"Happy is she who has believed in the fulfillment of the word of God." And it is still Mary who invites us to do the same: "Do whatever he tells you." Mary who, with the other disciples, is available, assiduous in prayer, waiting for the gift of the Holy Spirit. Mary is first in the spiritual family. She is in first place in the immense procession of God's friends. She is called Queen of the Apostles, Martyrs and Saints of God. If we choose to follow Jesus by the way of faith, we are united to him, we are his true friends, his real brothers and sister. By being attentive and welcoming His Word into our hearts, and by acting like Him with love, we do the will of God.

Why the Catholic Strong Campaign?

Since the arrival of Bishop Dennis Sullivan, a great deal of emphasis has been placed on the restructure and stability of the financial statement of the diocese. Under the guidance of William Murray, diocesan Chief Financial Officer, and the accounting staff, and with the mutual assistance of the Financial Council, the balance sheet of the diocese has improved dramatically.

In an effort to structure our Finance Council in a manner consistent with USCCB Guidelines, we choose to create an Institutional Advancement subcommittee for the purpose of exploring a capital campaign. Our committee was formed in the last quarter of 2016. With the permission of Bishop Sullivan, we solicited proposals from five national recognized firms, each of whom had extensive experience in diocesan-wide campaigns.

With further permission from Bishop Sullivan, we hired fundraising firm Changing Our World to conduct a feasibility and planning study in the early part of 2017. The study took six months to complete. Pastors and clergy of each parish were interviewed, as well as most department heads within the diocese. The outcome of the study was very positive. In particular, the pastors were very pleased about the revenue sharing provided by the campaign.

Each parish will receive 70 percent of the funds raised in their parish. This would allow them to consider paying down debt, making capital improvements, and focus on the critical needs of their parish. Those needs might also include resources to strengthen their local ministries.

In addition to the study, we believe success will come from a good economic environment that will likely continue. We pray you will join us in this very important endeavor and make a generous pledge to your parish community and support the spirit of stewardship for our diocese.






