

## From the desk of Deacon Rich Roenbeck, Pastoral Associate

Dear Parishioner,

In the words of Pope Francis, "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity tells us that we do not have a solitary God up there in heaven, far away. No, He is the Father who gave his Son, who became man like us, and who sends his own Spirit to be even closer to us."

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. On this solemnity, we are invited through the readings and psalm to reflect on the mystery of the Trinity – one God in three persons: the Father, the Son, and Holy Spirit – and what it means in our lives.

The Trinity features prominently in our lives as Catholics – we are baptized, forgiven for our sins and anointed in the name of the Trinity. We profess our faith in the Trinity when we recite the creed and when we mark ourselves with the Sign of the Cross. When we next make the sign of the cross, let us do it *prayerfully*, with reverence and understanding, *remembering how we are loved and must love in turn.* The doctrine is part of the very earliest teaching of the Church and occupies a central place in the life of the Church, underlying all major feasts such as Christmas, the Epiphany, Good Friday, Easter, the Ascension and Pentecost!

What do we really understand about the Trinity, what does it tell us about the God we believe in and what does this belief mean for us as we go about our daily lives?

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC), we are told that "There is one God, who has three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each Person is God, yet there is still only one God" (*CCC*, 253-256). The Catechism of the Catholic Church also teaches that "by sending his only Son and the Spirit of Love in the fullness of time, God has revealed his innermost secret: **God himself is an eternal exchange of love**, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and he has destined us to share in that exchange" (CCC, 221). The Father is the **Creator**, the Son is the **Redeemer** and the Holy Spirit is the **Sanctifier and the Counsellor**. All three persons in the Trinity are in such a perfect relationship in a unity of love that God is truly ONE.

As Catholic Christians, we are called to live the Holy Trinity each day. In the same way that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are one in love, we, who are created in the image and likeness of God, are called by our Father to live in a relationship of love with God and with his people.

## Readings of the Week

## Reading I: Proverbs 8:22-31

I was present at the creation of the world.

- In the first reading from Proverbs, Wisdom plays before God upon the earth that she helped bring into being.
- Lady Wisdom was begotten and brought forth by God and she was present as God's designer in the work of creation.
- The words delight and playing in today's passage, express the Creator's joy.

### Reading II: Romans 5:1-5

We are at peace.

- The reading from the Letter to the Romans developed the idea of Christ as our mediator with God.
- Christ has reconciled us to God, not because of any effort on our part, but because of the immense love of God
- We are strong because the Spirit of God lives in us. **Gospel : John 16:12-15**

The Father and I are one and the Holy Spirit will receive what I give and tell you about it.

- The reading from the Gospel of John is part of Jesus' discourse to the disciples the night before his death.
- Jesus promised to send the Spirit to the disciples to comfort and strengthen them after he had gone to the Father.
- Just as Jesus was the revealer of God, so the Spirit revealed God to the disciples.

**Question for Children:** God fills us with love. How, this week, will you show your family - your mom, dad, brothers, sisters, grandparents, cousins - that you love them as God loves them?

**Question for Youth:** When Jesus left the world, He sent the Holy Spirit to be with us. Have you ever given something important to someone else as a sign of your love for them? Have you ever experienced the Holy Spirit as a similar gift to you?



## Saint of the Week:

Augustine of Canterbury, Bishop, d. c. 605

Saint Gregory the Great, pope during Augustine's adult life, wanted to evangelize Anglo-Saxon England. He selected thirty monks, and their prior, Augustine. This group set out for England in 596. King Ethelbert was baptized the following year as well as many of his followers, though he did not force anyone to become Christian. Pope Gregory outlined for Augustine the steps that he should take to establish the Church of England. He was to substitute feast days of saints for heathen festivals. Pagan temples were to be purified and consecrated as Christian churches. Augustine continued to spread the faith and establish churches and abbeys. He died seven years after he arrived in England.

**Feast Day:** 27th of May.

**Augustine's message today:** Like many of us, Augustine had some doubts before he set off on his mission, but, with God's reassurance through the pope, he proceeded on to great successes.
