***The Nativity of St. John the Baptist***



Dear friends,

*Today, we are celebrating the Solemnity of St John the Baptist. He is the only saint — with the exception of the Virgin Mary — whose birth the liturgy celebrates and it does so because it is closely connected with the mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God.*

*Interestingly, unlike the other saints of the Church, St. John the Baptist enjoys a special privilege that is only rivaled by the Blessed Mother.*

*Our Lord revealed this primacy of St. John in the gospels, "Among those born of woman, none is greater than John the Baptist."*

*Saint John the Baptist's reason for his existence was to be the forerunner of Christ and the final prophet of God. "Before I knit you in the womb, I knew you."*

*The task was given to him to prepare Israel to receive the Christ, and his honor was to exclaim to the whole world: "Behold the Lamb of God!"*

*St. John the Baptist was testifying to Christ, pointing Him out, leading his own mother to faith. We too can aspire to follow John's example in always pointing to Christ and away from ourselves, pointing to Christ, not just in word, but in our lives: by our selfless love, by our penitence and joy, by our humility and faith.*

*John the Baptist was known for evangelization. By his example, we too can be evangelizers through our support of The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). This process, is establish for the universal Church, for individuals to become Catholic. This initiation process truly involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church.*

*The RCIA is a "spiritual journey" Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded. This journey is an opportunity for individuals and families wishing to inquire about the Catholic Faith as well as Baptized Christians seeking a deeper relationship with Christ within the Catholic Church experience God's grace.*

*Additionally, it is an opportunity for Catholics baptized as youth wishing to reconnect with their faith, to complete their Sacraments and find a church home.*

*In the spirit of St John the Baptist may we be living examples of Jesus' joy to all with whom we come in contact and faithfully lead those who do not know Christ to share in our catholic faith.*


