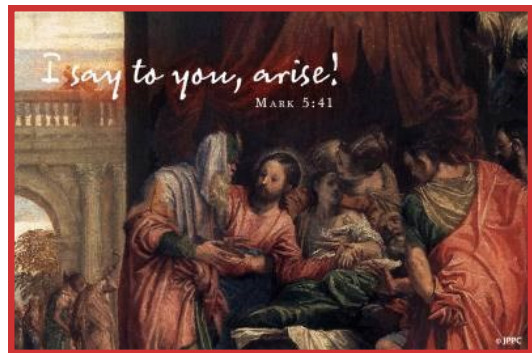

Dear Parishioners,

TRUST IN JESUS AND SHARE YOUR BLESSINGS!

These themes my friends highlight God's love and our call to live with faith and generosity, sharing our abundance to create equality, ensuring everyone's needs are met.

The readings for today show us that God wants nothing but life and goodness for us, if only we will let Him rescue us. Indeed, the first reading explains that God desires life for us, not death. While the second reading tells us that God desires abundance for all his children. And in the gospel, Jesus brings a young girl back to life and heals a woman who has been suffering for years.

These stories show us that everyone's encounter with Jesus can be different. Some may reach out to Jesus in faith, while others are touched by Jesus in their need. But in all cases, my friends, faith is key. When we face challenges, we must believe that Jesus is with us.

You see, sometimes we do not understand god's timing and actions. however, these stories show that Jesus knows what he is doing, and we must trust him even when we are confused or impatient. In fact, He encourages us to see others through God's eyes, recognizing their infinite worth regardless of their social status or material wealth.

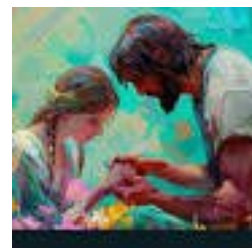

Readings of the Week

Reading I : Wisdom 1:13-15; 2:23-24

God does not make death.

- The author of the Book of Wisdom gives some insight into life after death.
- The idea of resurrection began to emerge in Israel only in the final two centuries before Christ.
- Today's reading presents the idea that righteousness cannot die. Therefore, the human relationship with God cannot die.

Reading II : 2 Corinthians 8:7, 9, 13-15

May you abound in your work of charity.

- In the second reading Paul encourages the Corinthian community to be generous in a collection for the poor Christians in Jerusalem.
- This kind of generosity, especially when it involves sacrifice, reveals the presence of the Holy Spirit.
- Giving to a community in need of financial support is a sign of church unity.

Gospel : Mark 5:21-43

The family's astonishment was complete!

- Jesus' miracles are a sign that the power of Satan is broken and the kingdom of God has arrived.
- The miracle in the center of today's Gospel is sandwiched between the parts of another. This is one of Mark's favorite techniques.
- One touch of Jesus' clothing and the woman with the hemorrhage is healed. The power of Satan is broken, and new life has entered the world

- In the Gospel, Jesus heals people and performs miracles. Discuss the following questions with your family: Why do you think Jesus heals people? How do you reach out to Jesus when you need help?
- With faith in Jesus, miracles and healing happens. Pray for someone who needs God's strength and healing in their lives.
- Discuss what the family can do to bring more happiness and joy into the life of someone who is suffering. Make plans to visit this person.
- Jesus performed many miracles. Miracles happen all around us every day. Plan a day trip with your family. Have each family member share one miracle he or she sees in the world.
