Message from Joseph Cray, Principal of Wildwood Catholic HS

Dear Friends,

Are you fully prepared? I think about this question often as I wake up to face the challenges of the day, as I plan for the upcoming months with my family, and as I guide the next generation of leaders who graduate from Wildwood Catholic High School. My name is Joe Cray, and I am fortunate to serve as principal of Wildwood Catholic High School. Working under the religious leadership of Father Wallace and alongside a talented, dedicated school staff, we strive to “fully prepare” the next generation.

As a student who went through twelve years of Catholic school in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, I developed characteristics that helped mold me into an educator and shape my decision making. One characteristic that started in the home and was further developed and nurtured was faith in God. Attending weekly mass and praying at home became the foundation of a strong commitment to my faith and my mission as a Catholic. Little did I know at the time, I was being prepared to lead a life of responsibility, perseverance, and integrity.

The faith in God deepened and the sense of community developed as I made the sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation with my classmates. Studying and memorizing every word of the Baltimore Catechism not only built a strong work ethic, but also helped me become focused and inquisitive. As we progressed through elementary, or “grade school,” as we called it, our teachers held the highest academic expectations and more importantly Catholic expectations. As we matured, we learned how to problem solve as opposed to just getting the right answers. When we needed help and guidance it was provided to us, and when we needed more we prayed and self-reflected.

In my years at West Catholic High School in Philadelphia I gained a sense of empathy as we learned about local, national, and worldly communities that thirsted for compassion, kindness, and generosity. We learned the importance of doing for others as we often participated in the Corporal Works of Mercy, giving to the poor and feeding the hungry. And of course, we grew to understand the importance of academic excellence. Appreciation for the sciences, arts, and world cultures was passed onto us by enthusiastic, charismatic, and sincere teachers. I would be remiss if I did not recognize the integral role Catholic education had in ensuring that I am fully prepared to be a charismatic educator, a compassionate community member, and a loving family member. I would also be negligent if I did not sincerely thank *you*, our parishioners, who continue to support Catholic education through your generosity. You have made all of these characteristics of a Catholic education accessible to countless students.



Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Question: How is a new Pope Chosen?

As the leader of the Catholic Church on earth, the pope takes on an important role as a shepherd for Catholics around the world. We can trace our papal heritage as a Church back to Peter, whom Jesus appointed as the first pope. But how is a new pope chosen today?

A new pope is chosen when the previous pope dies or resigns. Papal resignation is rare, but it is a part of our recent history: Pope Francis was elected after his predecessor, Pope Benedict XVI, resigned.

On the occasion of a vacancy in the papacy, the College of Cardinals convenes in the Vatican. They begin by celebrating Mass and invoking the Holy Spirit to guide them in choosing the new pope. Then, they start to vote by secret ballot. Cardinals under the age of 80 are eligible to vote, and there is a limit of 120 cardinal electors. Cardinals are not allowed contact with the media or people outside the conclave during the process of election.

All discussions and votes of the conclave are held in the Sistine Chapel. On the first day of the conclave, one vote is taken, and the votes are recorded and counted. A two-thirds majority is needed for a pope to be elected. If no consensus is reached on the first day, then the conclave continues on subsequent days. Four votes are held per day: two in the morning and two in the afternoon. When a vote is inconclusive, the cardinals burn the ballots and release black smoke over the chapel.

When an individual receives two-thirds of the votes and consents to becoming pope, the cardinals release white smoke above the chapel to indicate that a pope has been chosen. The senior cardinal deacon then announces, "Habemus Papam"—"We have a pope"—from the balcony in St. Peter's Square, and the new pope emerges in his vestments to offer a blessing.

Today, let us pray for Pope Francis and for all the cardinals who uphold the dignity of the papacy in the service of the Church.

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children in 1st-8th grade can either do our **School Year** program, which is held on scheduled Sundays , September-May at 9am followed by the 10:30 am mass at St. Ann's. Or our **Summer Intensive** program, which begins the last Monday in July through first week in August.

Teenagers in 9th-12th grade will be given a **RCIA** program geared to their age group.

Adults seeking the faith will be entered into the **RCIA** program. **RCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.


